### FR. ERIC – RAMBLINGS

### **REAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST IN THE EUCHARIST**

Christ is always present in His Church, especially in her liturgical celebrations. He is present in the sacrifice of the Mass, not only in the person of His minister but also under the Eucharistic species. By His power, He is present in the sacraments. He is present in His word, since it is He, Himself, who speaks when the Holy Scriptures are read in church. He is present, lastly, when the Church prays and sings, for He promised: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Mt. 18:20).



### Principles

- Christ is really and truly present under the form of bread and wine.
- The Eucharist contains the "whole Christ."
- In Holy Communion we share in God's own life.
- The Eucharist is both real and a symbol.
- Other modes of Christ's presence point toward the Real Presence in the sacramental species

### Question for reflection this week:

Am I really present to the presence of Christ in the Eucharist? What keeps me from being truly and really present to God at Mass?

### **REMEMBER ME**

Reflection on Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

Jesus gave us His most precious Body and Blood at the Last Supper, as a lasting nourishment. The Last Supper takes place within the Jewish tradition of Passover, a feast which celebrates God's liberation of His people from bondage. The key to celebrating Passover is the act of remembrance – remembering who God is and what God has done for His people, and remembering who we are as a people who belong to God.

In seminary I learned that the five-dollar word that theologians use for the kind of "remembering" we do when celebrating the Eucharist is "anamnesis" – which is not just mental recall, but a kind of remembering that makes present now the reality with which we are in touch.

When I learned this word, and realized that it shares the same root with the word "amnesia," which is, of course, all about forgetting who one is, I gained a precious insight into how I can more deeply prepare to celebrate the Eucharist. My hunger for this heavenly food increases when I not only remember the saving graces of God in my life, but also acknowledge what I have forgotten along the way. What do you tend to forget? That you are loved? That we are pilgrims (in process and not yet finished)? That we are called to be for others? That our fulfillment is not here? That we are more alike than different? That we are here for a reason?

Taste and see the goodness of the Lord!

### SAINT MÉDARD

Feast Day: June 8 • Patron Saint of Bad Weather

Médard was born in the middle of the fifth century in Picardy, France. He was ordained a priest when he was thirty-three and subsequently became one of the most adored and

highly recognized bishops in northern France. It is believed that when Médard was younger, he was once protected from bad weather by an eagle that flew right above his head. This legend led to his patronage of good weather and against bad weather, called upon by those who work outdoors. It is also said that whatever the weather is like on his feast day, it will be so for the next forty days.

St. Médard, entreat the Father of the Heavens and of this earth to protect us from bad weather just as He protected you in your time of need. Ask Him to comfort us with sunny skies, cool us with soft breezes, warm us with His love and sunlight. Please help keep this important day free from unexpected downpours and shelter us from all storms. Amen.

ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM - In July 2021 the Archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations world-wide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider - Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. As the Archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided.
