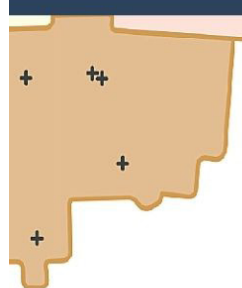

## CLEAR VISION

*Reflection on Luke 6:39-45*

The blind leading the blind, removing splinters from my own eyes or the eyes of others – these images in this Gospel, as well as the exhortation to bring out the goodness that is stored in our hearts – all go to the reality of our vision. What do we see when we look upon the world, upon ourselves, upon others?
