Father Jim Duell was born April 20, 1952 in Dayton, OH. He is the youngest of four children of Roland and Marie Duell. He attended St. Rita Elementary School in Shiloh, northwest Dayton, Chaminade High School and St. Gregory Preparatory Seminary, graduating in 1970. Father Jim was ordained a priest by then Archbishop Joseph Bernardin, March 20, 1982. He has recently celebrated both his 70th Birthday and 40th Anniversary of Ordination to the priesthood.

His parish assignments have included: St. Charles Borromeo in Kettering; St. Brigid, Xenia; Holy Trinity, Coldwater; St. Jude, Bridgetown Cincinnati; and has been a Pastor at St. Teresa, Covington; Immaculate Conception, Bradford; St. Patrick, Troy. The last five years, he was pastor, second time at St. Teresa, Covington; Parochial Vicar at St. Denis, Versailles; Holy Family, Frenchtown and Immaculate Conception, Bradford. He also was Catholic Chaplain at Good Samaritan Hospital in Dayton.

His hobbies include golf, swimming, movies, gardening, music and reading. Fr. Jim will reside at St. Teresa Parish in Covington.

## ALL IN

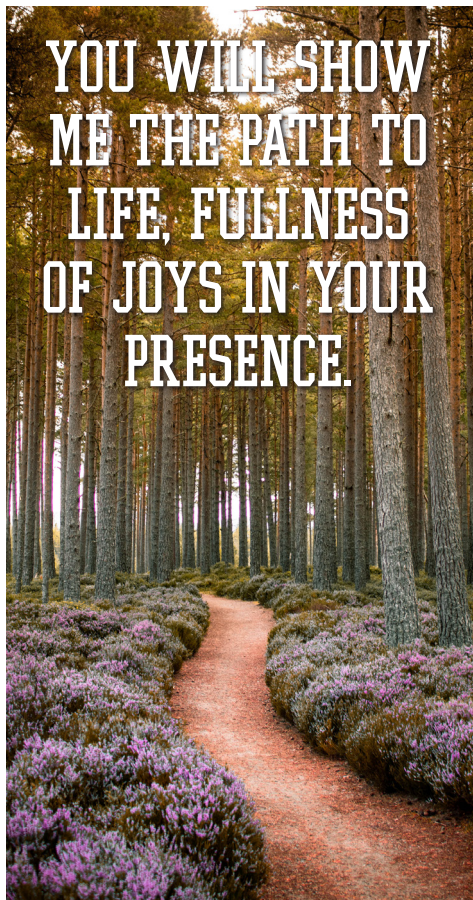
Reflection on Luke 9:51-62

Every disciple of Jesus, whatever their particular mission or vocation may be, has been called to freedom and promised that the Spirit will guide them. Beyond this call and promise, discipleship is a risky leap to become all that God's grace can enable us to be.

The Gospel today reminds us of one of the principle dynamics of living as a disciple of Christ that we will inevitably confront: the dynamic of *letting go* in order to *draw near*. Note the three persons invited to follow Jesus: the impulsive one who hasn't factored in the risks, the one concerned about burying his father, and the one wanting to take care of matters at home. It seems that what they all have in common is the challenge of *letting go* of certain circumstances in order to *draw near* to the single-mindedness and single-heartedness necessary for the work of proclaiming the reign of God.

Take some time this week to meditate on your own circumstances. What might stand in the way of your "all-in" commitment to discipleship?

## SAINT CYRIL OF ALEXANDRIA

Feast Day: June 27

Patron Saint of Ecumenism

Saints are not born with halos around their heads. Cyril, recognized as a great teacher of the Church, began his career as archbishop of Alexandria, Egypt, with impulsive, often violent, actions.

Cyril's importance for theology and Church history lies in his championing the cause of orthodoxy against the heresy of Nestorius, who taught that in Christ there were two persons, one human and one divine.

The controversy centered around the two natures in Christ. Nestorius would not agree to the title "God-bearer" for Mary. He preferred "Christ-bearer," saying there are two distinct persons in Christ – divine and human – joined only by a moral union. He said Mary was not the mother of God but only of the man Christ, whose humanity was only a temple of God. Nestorianism implied that the humanity of Christ was a mere disguise. Presiding as the pope's representative at the Council of Ephesus in 431, Cyril condemned Nestorianism and proclaimed Mary truly the "God-bearer" – the mother of the one Person who is truly God and truly human.

Besides needing to soften some of his opposition to those who had sided with Nestorius, Cyril had difficulties with some of his own allies, who thought he had gone too far, sacrificing not only language but orthodoxy. On his deathbed, despite pressure, he refused to condemn the teacher of Nestorius.

Lives of the saints are valuable not only for the virtue they reveal but also for the less admirable qualities that also appear. Holiness is a gift of God to us as human beings. Life is a process. We respond to God's gift, but sometimes with a lot of zigzagging. If Cyril had been more patient and diplomatic, the Nestorian church might not have risen and maintained power so long. But even saints must grow out of immaturity, narrowness, and selfishness. It is because they – and we – do grow, that we are truly saints, persons who live the life of God.

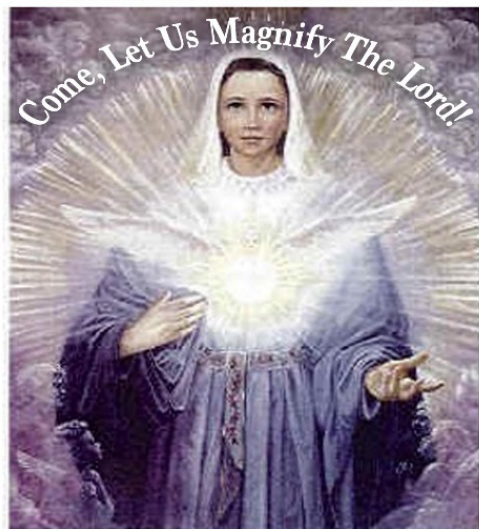
