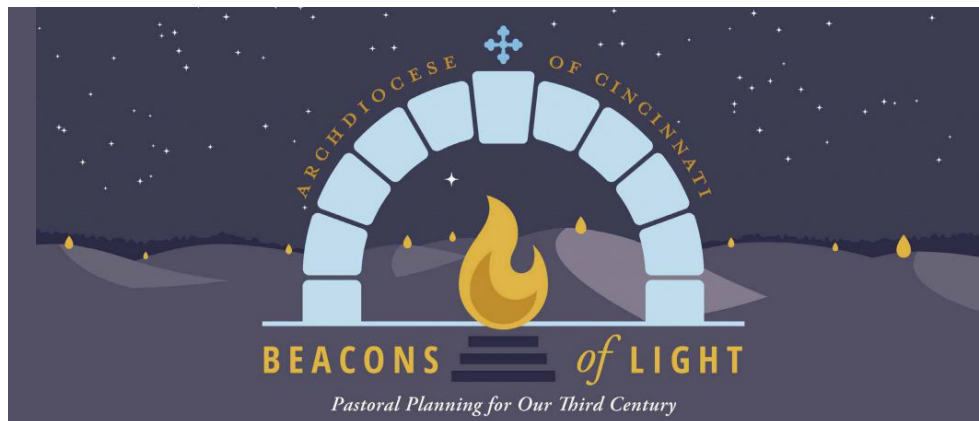

## FR. ERIC – RAMBLINGS

## FR. ERIC WENT “CAMPING” AT DAMASCUS.....

This past week, I spent three days with several of our young people (6th to 12th grade) at the Catholic Summer Youth Camp (CYSC) at a place in Ohio called Damascus. This camp is set on a 450-acre plot of land, once owned by an NBA basketball player who wanted his property used for a Bible/Youth camp, north of Columbus near Mount Vernon. The mission of the Damascus Youth Campus is just as St. Paul encountered the Living God on the road to Damascus. Damascus Catholic Mission Campus is a place of encounter where a generation is *awakened, empowered, and equipped* to live the adventure of the Catholic faith. According to recent studies, five out of six young people Confirmed will no longer be practicing their Catholic faith within ten years of their Confirmation. Over half of Americans raised Catholic no longer identify as such. There are a variety of reasons why nearly 70% of American Catholics no longer attend Mass regularly or believe the Bible and Church teaching guide their moral decision-making process, but the bottom line is God is not a part of their lives. To counter this ever-growing trend of young people leaving their faith and embracing the voice of the world, Damascus seeks to help our young people find something greater: Our Living God. The missionaries who work for Damascus, which would include the camp counselors, the kitchen and cleaning staff, the leadership team, the speakers, the musicians, the nursing staff and the clergy and religious, seek to inspire the hearts of the young people to be consumed with the Love of God and not the things of this world, to teach the faith with joy and vibrancy and to be excited to live their call as the living stones that build the foundation of the future of our Church. What I witnessed during my three-day-stay at the camp (only half of the week...which, by the way, was all my body could take) was such faith, love of God and so much energy. The Damascus missionaries, the counselors, and speakers, brought such hope to my heart as a result of their faith and their fearless expression of their Love for God. I witnessed so many young adults kneeling and praying before the Blessed Sacrament, with such intensity. I witnessed our young people, high school and jr. high youth, praying and singing and worshipping God with such energy it was contagious. All that I witnessed during these three short days has refreshed and re-energized my heart and my spirit to LOVE GOD with even more of my whole being. Please continue to pray for our young people, pray for our young adults, and pray for the mission of Damascus.

## ASK, SEEK AND KNOCK

Reflection on Luke 11:1-13

Ask, seek and knock, and you will receive, find, and the door will be opened to you. We have this promise directly from Jesus. We also have it directly from Jesus that if we ask God for a fish, we won't get a snake, and if we ask for an egg, we won't get a scorpion. We can go to God for the fish and egg special and be assured that we will not get something unfriendly, inedible, or poisonous instead.

One key to understanding prayer is the simple truth that what we want and what we need are two separate realities. God can see the difference, if we cannot. Prayer is going to the God who has promised to work all things to the good for those that love Him, not in any attempt to change God's will, but in a sincere desire to learn God's will for us. We pray so that we might be changed.

We have all heard the warning, "be careful what you ask for...." This is a good instruction for approaching the Lord's Prayer, because we are really asking, seeking, knocking - in these words Jesus taught us - to be changed, by our Father's Holy Name, into doers of His will.
