WHAT'S NEXT FOR OUR FAMILY OF PARISHES...?

The next step in our journey with Catholic Leadership Institute to becoming one parish family is the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The Disciple Maker Index is a survey tool that invites parishioners to reflect on where they are on their journey of discipleship and identify their parish's effectiveness in supporting that journey. Utilizing a unique, cutting-edge technology, the tool gathers comprehensive feedback about parishioners' spiritual growth through 75 questions. The resulting insight is invaluable: It enables parish leadership to make data-driven decisions regarding priorities that will ultimately help parishioners grow in faith. As of 2018, the tool has been used in more than 400 parishes in 20 dioceses throughout the United States and Canada. More than 100,000 parishioners have participated, providing a rich resource of helpful benchmarks from parishes of all settings and sizes.

So, the question on your mind might be, "Why should I participate?" Your responses will give us a wealth of information and feedback. The data will be an invaluable asset to the pastor and key parish leaders. The data will help give clarity on our path toward setting priorities and goals to grow our parishes.

Over the next few weeks, there will be opportunities to take the Disciple Maker Index either electronically, which is preferred, or with a hard copy. I am asking everyone to take the time, about 20 minutes, to take the Disciple Maker Index.

A LIFE OF PRAYER

Reflection on Luke 18:1-8

We are presented in these readings with Moses, a great leader of his people, and a nameless woman who is a disenfranchised widow on the margins of society. Both are pleading for something they dearly want. It would be easy to reduce these stories to the lesson that if we are persistent in prayer, God will give us what we ask for.

There is something deeper here. Toward the end of the Gospel story, Jesus refers to, "his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." This is something more than persistence. It calls us to choose a lifestyle of prayer; to experience prayer not as something we do, or an accomplishment, but as a state of being. Prayer is the awareness of God in everything, engagement with God in all of life, and ultimately prayer is abandonment to God.

Calling out to God day and night, we embrace prayer as a way of life that is as natural as breathing. The persistence that is recommended by Jesus will transform us, so that in the end, it is not what I want or desire that is important, but rather what God wills.




