FORGIVENESS

Reflection on Luke 19:1-10

We hear that Zacchaeus is "seeking to see Jesus," and discover that Jesus, with even more ardor, is seeking Zacchaeus, to embrace him and dine with him. What a wonder is God's patience with us sinners as we figure out how to respond to His love and mercy! It is even more of a wonder to know that God uses this sinner (me), as He did Zacchaeus, to teach others about forgiveness.

Sometimes we aren't so happy to see people whose sins are different from ours dining at the same table of the Lord with us. But Jesus, the source of love, the wellspring of mercy, the hope of sinners, is seeking each and every human person, urging all of human history toward a perfect union with our Creator. In Jesus, God is gathering up the fragments, seeking out the lost, that nothing and no one may be wasted.

Maybe we each have to see ourselves as Zacchaeus, and each see ourselves as the self-righteous who do not want a sinner near us, and each see ourselves as Christ, with an embrace wide enough to accept anyone looking for the Lord. ~ Fr. Jay




