GIVE CATHOLIC 2022

We have been informed that due to shortage of staff to implement the program, the GIVE Catholic Archdiocese of Cincinnati will not be held this year. The Stewardship Department Communications Manager staff position is responsible for running all aspects of the Giving Tuesday program. The person that held this position took another job this past May and a replacement has not yet been found, so the decision was made to discontinue the program. While we are disappointed in this news, Giving Tuesday continues on Tuesday, November 29, 2022.

Giving Tuesday is a global generosity movement unleashing the power of radical generosity. Giving Tuesday was created in 2012 as a simple idea: A day that encourages people to do good. JESUS SAVES

Reflection on Luke 23:35-43

The liturgical year comes to an end this weekend with this Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. The end of the year points toward the end of time, when all creation culminates where it originated: in Christ. This is when what we ask for in the Lord's Prayer is given for all eternity – when His Kingdom comes, in all its fullness; when God's will is done, in all its completeness.

One of the hardest truths for us to accept is that we cannot save ourselves. The world constantly tells us to "take care of yourself," to "look out for number one." In the kingdoms of this world, we are led to believe that we can and must save ourselves.

But as Christians we always come back to the belief that nobody saves themselves. Even Jesus, when hanging on the cross, is taunted to "save yourself." It is through His death and Resurrection, that is in refusing to save Himself, that Jesus saves us, saves us all, and comes into the fullness of His Kingdom, where He "remembers us."

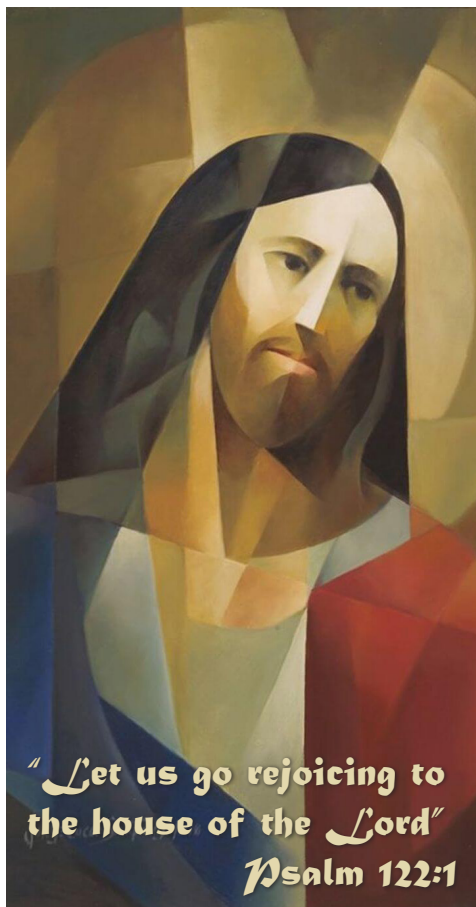

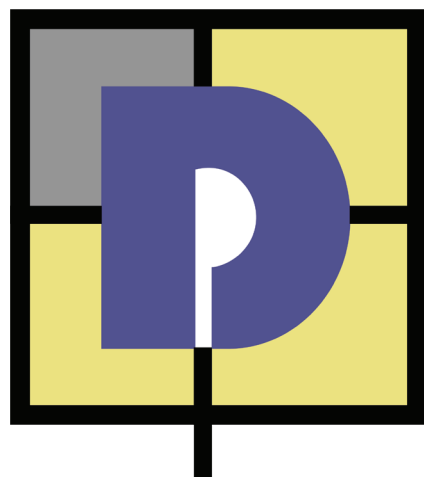

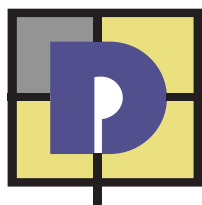
