As you may have noticed, we have begun the process of updating our sound system! This endeavor has been approved by Parish Council and financed through a generous parishioner bequest. We are working with an actual sound engineer in order to get the best working system we can for our particular situation. We are also planning to instruct those using the ambo in order to better utilize that microphone. All priests will be using head or earpiece microphones which will eventually be set to each individual. Due to supply chain shortages, this will not be completed until sometime in the Spring. We have also moved the ambo to the side of the sanctuary to help with the sound. Please bear with us and know that we are diligently working on this!

LOST AND FOUND

Reflection on Luke 15:1-32

I call today's Gospel reading the "lost and found" section of Luke's Gospel. A sheep, a coin, and a boy have been lost, and found. Notice the context for these three lost-and-found stories: Jesus is defending Himself against the criticism of associating with sinners. Not repentant sinners – even Pharisees dealt with them – but with sinners who kept on sinning, which sounds like God finds what is lost whether it wants to be found or not. But don't you finally have to repent? Yes, of course sinners must repent for God's forgiveness to be fully embraced. But the context seems more to emphasize the nature of God as a magnet of love and mercy than our squandering human nature.

From Jesus' point of view, any effort to find someone who is lost is worth it to God. When someone strays, God looks for her in all the likely and unlikely places. This is God who is on the road, watching and waiting for us to appear so God can run to embrace us. A God who acts so rashly, with such irresponsible and irrepressible love, may scandalize the respectable, but certainly gives hope to many a poor sinner, including this one.

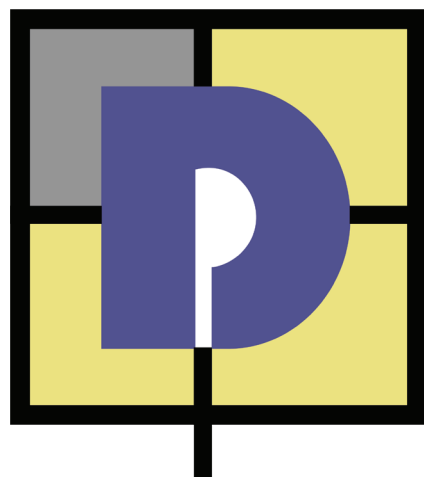

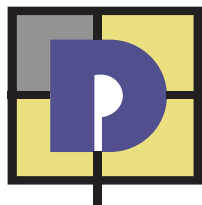
