FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS



THE PRAYERS OF FATIMA

The third prayer of Fatima, the Eucharistic prayer, was given to the children of Fatima at the end of the May visit. Lucia had asked Our Blessed Mother if she would take them to heaven and the response of

Our Blessed Mother was, "Yes, you will go to heaven, and Jacinta and Francisco, but he would have to say many Rosaries first." Lucia also asked about a few other people.

Then, Our Blessed Mother asked, "Will you offer yourselves to God, and bear all the sufferings He sends you, in atonement for all the sins that offend Him and for the conversion of sinners?"

"Oh, we will, we will!" Lucia said for them all.

"Then you will have a great deal to suffer," the Lady said, "but the grace of God will be with you and will strengthen you."

Lucia describes this moment, "As she pronounced these words, she opened her hands, and we were bathed in a heavenly light that appeared to come directly from her hands. The light's reality cut into our hearts and our souls, and we knew somehow that this light was God, and we could see ourselves embraced in it. By an impulse of clear and exterior grace we fell to our knees, repeating in our hearts: 'Oh, Most Holy Trinity, I adore You! My God, my God, I love You in the Most Blessed Sacrament."

After a few moments Our Lady told them to, "Pray the Rosary every day, in order to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war." Lucia then describes Our Blessed Mother's ascent to heaven, "The light that surrounded her seemed to open up a path before her in the firmament, and, for this reason, we sometimes said that we saw heaven opening." Lucia wrote that after Our Blessed Mother had given the children the prayer of worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament and then told them to pray the rosary every day, it was, "That we saw heaven opening." It is as if Our Blessed Mother gave the world what is needed to open heaven, the Most Holy Eucharist and Her Immaculate Heart.


