OUR LADY OF FATIMA

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – ST. FRANCISCO THE GENTLE SOUL - PT. 2



Francisco was born June 11, 1908, the sixth of seven children of Manuel and Olimpia Marto. He loved games and other children, yet without the spirit of competition. He was a peacemaker, but courageous, as his conduct, under questioning by the mayor, would later show.

He also had a mischievous turn. He was known to drop strange and inedible objects in his sleeping brother's mouth. Francisco's brother John indicated that Francisco risked scolding when he had a mind to carry out some practical joke – like the time John was sleeping with his mouth open near the stove, and

Francisco dropped a chip of wood into it. His father recalled that once or twice he refused to say his prayers because he was in a rebellious mood. He was strongly corrected. His father saw him defending his interest with a strong will.

He had a love for nature and animals in particular. He played with lizards and snakes, and would bring them home, to his mother's chagrin. Decorating his tomb at the Basilica of Fatima are pictures or statues of animals and nature. In particular, a small statue of a bird sits on top of the tomb. This is reference to a wonderful story that shows the beautiful gentle soul of Francisco. A young boy in the village had caught a small bird and was slowly plucking out the feathers. Francisco heard the bird and asked the boy to let it go. The boy got defiant, and Francisco simply reached in his pocket and took out two coins and traded them for the bird, which he released.






