

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS - ST. FRANCISCO THE GENTLE SOUL - PT. 6



On December 23, 1918, Francisco developed bronchial pneumonia. He said he would go to heaven soon, and added, "Oh, when I am there, I will console Jesus and Our Lady a great deal!" "While he was ill, Francisco always seemed joyful and content. I (Lucia) asked him sometimes, "Are you suffering a lot, Francisco?" He'd reply, "Quite a lot, but nevermind! I am suffering to console Our Lord, and afterwards, within a short time, I am going to heaven!"

The day before he died, Sr. Lucia writes, "He said to me: 'Look! I am very ill; it won't be long now before I go to heaven.'" She said, "Don't forget to pray a great deal for sinners, for the Holy Father, for me and Jacinta." He said, "Yes, I'll pray. But look, you'd better ask Jacinta to pray for these things instead, because I'm afraid I'll forget when I see Our Lord. And then, more than anything else, I want to console Him."

As the time grew short for Francisco, he asked Lucia to come for a visit, because he wanted to ask her something. Sr. Lucia recorded this encounter in her memoirs:

"I am going to Confession so that I can receive Holy Communion, and then die. I want you to tell me if you have seen me commit any sin, and then go ask Jacinta if she has seen me commit any." When I gave him this message (a sin Jacinta remembered), he answered: "I've already confessed those, but I'll do so again. Maybe, it is because of these sins that I committed that Our Lord is so sad..." Then, he bowed his head and prayed the prayer taught to them by Our Lady after the vision of hell: "O My Jesus, forgive us, save us from the fire of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are most in need." On the following day (from the previous event), after Francisco received Holy Communion from the parish priest, he said: "I am happier than you are, because I have the Hidden Jesus within my heart. I'm going to Heaven, but I'm going to pray very much to Our Lord and Our Lady for them to bring you both there soon. That night, I said goodbye to him. Goodbye, Francisco! If you go to heaven tonight, don't forget me when you get there, do you hear me?" Francisco added, "No, I won't forget. Be sure of that." Then, seizing my hand, he held it tightly for a long time, looking at me with tears in his eyes. "Do you want anything more?" I asked him with tears running down my cheeks, too. "No," he answered in a low voice. "Goodbye then, Francisco, till we meet in heaven, goodbye."

Heaven was drawing near. He took his flight to heaven the following day in the arms of his Heavenly Mother. I could never describe how much I missed him. This grief was a thorn that pierced my heart for years to come." April 4, at ten o'clock, he died with a glow on his shrunken face. He was buried the next day in a little cemetery in Fatima, across from the parish church, and later translated to the Sanctuary at Cova da Iria.

What faith, what love, what depths even children are capable of in the spiritual life. We must never fail in offering children the fullness of true faith or hinder the workings of God in their tender souls. And to us, in the Apostolate, we can hear Jesus say, "Unless you change, and become as little children, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven." – Mt 18:2-5


