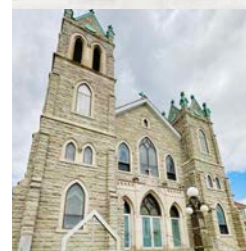

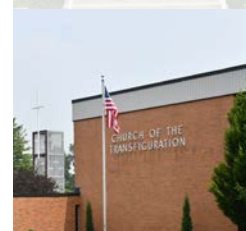

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – VENERABLE LUCIA: THE LONELY MARIAN APOSTLE – PT. 1



In this next series of lessons from Fatima, we will explore the oldest of the three seers, Lucia. In the June visit from Our Blessed Mother, Lucia asked if the three children would be taken to heaven. Our Heavenly Mother's response was, "Yes, I will take Jacinta and Francisco soon. But you are to stay here some time longer. Jesus wishes to make use of you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart."

As it turns out, some time later would actually be 86 years later on February 13, 2005. When you think about all that she experienced during those 86 years, what the world has experienced – it highlights, it reinforces the need for devotion of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Lucia experienced not one, but two world wars, the rise of Nazism and death camps, the systematic eradication of the Jewish people. Then, the rise of Communism and the spread of atheistic governments. More wars, the rise of Terrorism – 9/11 – and its impact on the world.

Lucia de Jesus Santos was born on March 28, 1907. Lucia tells us, "Asked when I was born – I heard my mother recount in an interview with Fr. Manuel Formigao, who had asked her my date of birth – my mother answered: 'We say it is on March 22 because she is registered as having been born on that day, but this is actually not true. She was born on March 28, 1907.' Only then did I learn the real date of my birth. This wasn't surprising, because in Fatima at the time we didn't attach any importance to one's birthday, nor did we celebrate it; we did not speak about the subject." Sr. Lucia does relate an interesting story about the choice of her name and who made it. Her godfather was Anastacio Vieira, a friend of her father's. Her godmother was Maria Rosa Marto, the daughter of Jacinta and Francisco's uncle, Jose Pedro Marto. Lucia recounts the story, "My father invited a young neighbor to be my godmother. She was the goddaughter of my mother... she gladly accepted and asked her father's permission... her father asked what they would name the little girl. She told him it would be Maria Rosa, because her mother already had four daughters and none of them had that name. Her father said, 'No! You have to name her Lucia! If not, I won't give you permission to be her godmother.' She went to tell my parents, who were surprised, and asked, 'But where did your father get that name?' The following story is taken from "The Shepherds of Fatima" by Fr. Silva. What makes this story so interesting is that the custom of the day was to give the youngest daughter her mother's name, or a boy, his father's. It is worth pointing out, also, that Lucia means, "she who shines." Lucia was entrusted by Our Lady of the Rosary with the task of spreading the message of Fatima to the four corners of the world.
