

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – VENERABLE LUCIA: THE LONELY MARIAN APOSTLE – PT. 2

Lucia was the youngest of seven. Fr. De Marchi described her features in the following manner: "She was not a pretty child. The only attractions of her face – which was not on the whole repellent – were her two great black eyes which gazed out from under thick eyebrows. Her hair, thick and dark, was parted in the center over her shoulders. Her nose was rather flat, her lips thick and her mouth large." She was a fabulous storyteller with a gift for narration. Her sister Maria do Anjos recounts, "We loved her very much because she was very intelligent and loving. When, as a little girl she would return home with the cattle, she would throw herself into her mother's arms. Holding her closely, she would play with her, hugging and kissing her." Contrast this beautiful image of Lucia in her mother's arms to 1917, when Maria Rosa thought her daughter was lying and deceiving everyone. Lucia's mother was very harsh, even brutal at times trying to convince Lucia to tell the truth – to tell everyone that she had not seen Our Lady. As she once said, "Why would Our Lady come to you?"

Lucia was much loved by the other kids in the village. They would play games, and she would tell stories. At one point, Maria Rosa was put in charge of the local kids while the parents were at work. An excerpt from a book by Fr. João M. de Marchi, I.M.C.: "Lucia would dress up the little children with flowers or ivy, hold processions with the holy pictures, and organize games...if they were in the church, she would sing hymns to Our Lady...and end everything with a blessing."

Lucia remembers these precious moments with the neighbor kids in her memoirs when she writes, "They would run up next to me, excited and happy, and when they knew I would be taking my flock around the village, groups of them would come along to spend the day with me. My mother used to say: 'I don't know what attraction you could have; the children run to be with you as if there were some feast!' But as for me, I often felt ill at ease in the midst of so much screaming, and so for that reason I would try to hide."


