

STRATEGIC PLANNING STRUCTURE PART 1

The next several weeks will include the key aspects of a strategic plan. As Beacons of Light continues, Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes, according to Catholic Leadership Institute and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, has been identified as being ahead of the curve in many markers. OLF now embarks into year-two of strategic planning. Beacons of Light offers the Families of Parishes in the Archdiocese a "Pastoral Planning Pathway" to provide six principles and key guidelines and parameters to build a mission-driven parish life as each Family works toward becoming one canonical parish. A strategic plan can help an organization achieve long-term success by providing direction, improving decision-making and managing resources. It can help anticipate and prepare for what's likely to happen, even including unfavorable scenarios.

Strategic planning can be beneficial for any organization, business or church, regardless of size. Here are some benefits of strategic planning:

- Creates a unified vision to align towards common goals.
- Identifies and addresses biases in decision making to improve that process.
- Aligns organizational resources, activities and goals to enhance resource management.
- Increases operational efficiency to anticipate trends and adapt to changing circumstances.
- Gives staff and key volunteers a sense of purpose which becomes a motivator to do jobs well.
- Provides an advantage to organizations to identify unique capabilities and areas where they perform well or better than those in their industry.

Strategic planning involves stepping back from day-to-day operations to ask where the organization is headed and what its priorities should be. It involves analyzing internal strengths and weaknesses, considering new opportunities and external threats and developing a plan to achieve overall goals.

Morgan's Place was established to assist families through the grieving process when experiencing the loss of a baby. They aid this process by memory-making, birth planning, funeral and burial services and postpartum support groups for parents.

The Verdier family dedicated two and half acres of their farmland not only for the burial of their unborn babies, Morgan and Marion, but also to assist others who suffer similar losses.

Ways that Morgan's Place serves includes: Liaison to the Funeral Home, Funeral Planning, Burial in Morgan's Place Cemetery, Grave Marker Design and Placement, Grief Support, Post-Abortion Healing, Birth Planning, Memorial Wall (providing parents a place to recognize their babies that were not able to be buried).

All services are provided at no cost to the family.




