VICAR'S VOICE



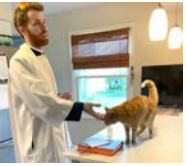
May the peace of Jesus Christ be with you. Thank you for the opportunities to bless your homes. It was a joy to spend some time with you, to get to know you and your family better and to pray with you. Throughout the last three weeks of Easter, after the announcement of a competition between two Ordination classes, I blessed 55 houses. The priest class of 2022 blessed 247 houses during Easter and the priest class of 2023 (my class) blessed...247 houses, as well! Who would have thunk?! My competitive spirit says we could have found one more home. My more realistic side says no one really loses in this endeavor. It was about blessing homes and hearts, first and foremost. This sounds perhaps cheesy, but the lived experience is as far from it as the east is from the west.



The point of the house blessing is to welcome Christ into the homes and hearts of the domestic church – the family unit – so that the joy and peace of the Son of God might bring about a renewal of life. While the house is blessed, it is the hearts or souls in the house that make use of such a blessing. The popular saying is, “The home is where the heart is.” If the heart makes its home in the peace of Christ, it needs little else from other people, and what the soul needs from Christ through others it can more easily acquire. Furthermore, such a mind and soul at peace jumps at the opportunity to love Christ fervently in others, caring for their needs without counting costs and unconcerned about rewards. A person doesn't count costs when they have more than enough to go around. So it is in spiritual life. Filled with Christ, we can't help but live differently and generously. House blessings are one good way to enter deeper into the mysterious and inexhaustible love of Christ. As we tailor our wills and souls to Christ, He will make a home in our hearts which we will find harder and harder to leave. Praise the Lord!

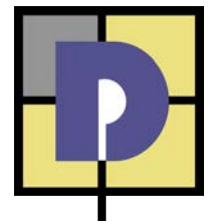
