STRATEGIC PLANNING STRUCTURE PART 4 – VISION

The Vision Statement provides what our hope is to achieve in the future. As the Family of Parishes upholds the Mission and achieves the priorities/goals/objectives/tasks within the strategic plan, the Vision serves as our long-term strategic intent.

VISION: Our Lady of Fatima parish will be one community of missionary disciples who radiate Christ in their lives and to those around them.

“What does it mean to be a ‘missionary disciple?’” A disciple is one who follows and through the “following” is taught how to be like the leader. In our case, a disciple is one who follows Jesus, and learns how to be more like Jesus.

A missionary disciple is one, that in following Jesus, reaches a point in their relationship with Him, that they begin to live out the great commission found at the end of Mathew’s Gospel. “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you,” Matthew 28:19-20. The call of the great commission is to “go” and invite everyone to a relationship with God. The disciples spent three years learning at the feet of Jesus, all that he taught, all the miracles, all His homilies, His passion, death and glorious Resurrection. They needed this time of following accompanied with an outpouring of the Holy Spirit before they were missionary disciples. That said, our Vision will take time to achieve, just as it did for the apostles/disciples, before they were ready to go into the world or for us to go into Miami County and the surrounding area bringing everyone to Jesus.

By following the Mission Statement, we will be on the path to reach our Vision Statement.

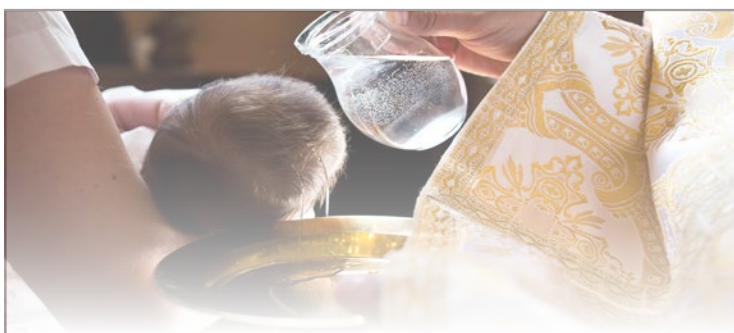

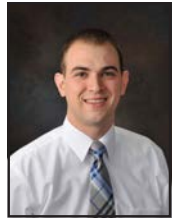
