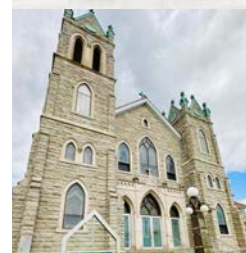

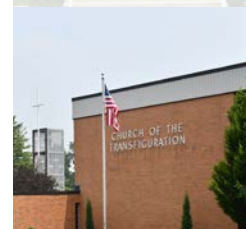

BEACONS OF LIGHT: WHY ARE WE DOING IT?

As we move into the third year of the Beacons of Light initiative, Beacons of Light Corner will feature recaps of what Beacons of Light is and will continue to shed light and alleviate confusion about the process.

Beacons of Light was launched as a resolution to several major issues/challenges within our Archdiocese. The biggest challenge was the shortage of priests, not only in the total number of priests, but also, the number of priests who could be ready to handle the rigors and challenges of being assigned as pastor. While the Archdiocese has been on the upward trend with vocations, thanks be to God, the number of priests who are due to retire in the next few years far outweighs the growth currently. Coupled with the issue of declining numbers of priests, is the "lone wolf" mentality. So many priests have been "forced" to live and work alone, which is generally not healthy for the priest and by extension, not healthy for the holy people of God. The other, and probably more important issue, is the decline in church attendance. According to a March 2023 poll from the Public Religion Research Institute, 10.3% fewer Americans identified as Catholic in 2023 than in 2013. This is the largest decline of any religious group in the United States. The projection in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati shows that the northern region is significantly lower than it is in Cincinnati or even Dayton. This translates to a decline in resources but yet a continued expectation of the function of a full church. In other words, no one wants their Mass time to be dropped, for staff to be reduced, a reduction in the number of ministries and activities, events or Festivals, but there has been fewer people and less money. There are additional challenges, but these are the biggest, all pointing to action having been needed to more effectively utilize resources.

Therefore, the decision was made to reduce the number of "parishes" within our Archdiocese. It is important to keep in mind that on the surface, this statement could sound like parishes will be closing. That is not necessarily the full picture. An important distinction needs to be made. In America, we interchange the words "parish" and "church" as the same entity. In our church vernacular, they have two very different meanings. A Catholic parish is a community of Christians within a specific church. It is the lowest level of ecclesiastical subdivision in the Catholic Church and is the main unit that makes up a diocese. The term "parish" comes from the Latin word "parochia:" a group of neighboring dwellings. As the community of believers, the Church is the assembly (ekklesia) of all who believe in Jesus Christ; or the fellowship (koinonia) of all who are bound together by their common love for the Savior. In other words, the parish is the community of believers as a whole, and church is where they gather to worship. As we move forward with Beacons of Light, these distinctions will be important.

We will explore more about the distinctions between "parish" and "church" and how we will reach our goal of becoming a new, unified canonical parish.
