#### STRATEGIC PLANNING STRUCTURE PART 3

An effective Mission Statement drives all that we do on a daily basis and puts the strategic plan in action.

**MISSION:** Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes accompanies people in becoming disciples of Christ through community, sacraments, scripture and prayer.

The key Values of community, sacraments, scripture and prayer are found in Our Lady of Fatima's Mission. They are the pillars that hold up our work.

**COMMUNITY:** One Body of Christ, as one parish family united in vision, sacrifice and the call to missionary discipleship.

**SACRAMENTS:** A Sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to dispense grace. It is through the sacraments that we encounter our Living God.

**SCRIPTURE:** Those divinely-revealed realities that are contained and presented in Sacred Scripture have been committed to writing under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. For Holy Mother Church, relying on the belief of the Apostles, holds that the books of both the Old and New Testaments in their entirety are sacred and canonical because written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, they have God as their author and have been handed on as such to the Church herself.

**PRAYER:** Prayer is "the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God." It is an act of the moral virtue of religion, which Catholic theologians identify as a part of the cardinal virtue of justice. Prayer may be expressed vocally or mentally.

The call of our Mission is for everyone – clergy, staff, commissions, lay leaders and every individual in the pews – to seek a relationship with our Holy Triune God. The path to this relationship or a deepening of this relationship is found, while not the only way, but the most impactful way, through the Values contained in our Mission Statement.
