OUR LADY OF FATIMA BEACONS of LIGHT CORNER

In the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, to support the Beacons of Light process, parishes are encouraged to evaluate staffing needs to meet the demands of a larger parish family and a consolidated staff. With five parishes and only four priests, the clergy and parish staff are stretched thin, striving to serve all parishioners and parish sites. This same stress is compounded for Fr. Eric, as he not only leads the parish staff and has necessary administrative oversight but is also needed for his pastoral duties - the primary duties of his vocation as a priest. Our Lady of Fatima is not alone in dealing with this tension between administrative and pastoral duties. As the number of priests across the US has declined, the Church has fewer pastors per number of Catholics, further compounding the situation.

With this in mind, parishes in the Archdiocese are developing a staff position that frees the pastor to focus more on pastoral responsibilities. This allows for increased evangelization and the accompaniment of parishioners in their ministerial and spiritual needs. It provides staff and ministries consistent daily leadership. After evaluating the realistic needs of our parish family with the guidance of our Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI) leadership consultant, Our Lady of Fatima is adding a new lay position, Executive Director of Pastoral Services, to manage day-to-day operations, lead the staff, guide communication initiatives and provide administrative support to the pastor, and by extension, the clergy.

"Our Lady of Fatima is poised for continued growth over the next decade. Finding a smart way to manage this growth is going to be critical for the long-term viability of the parish family," said Kate Sell, CLI's leadership consultant who has been working with Our Lady of Fatima for the past two years. "More and more parishes nationwide are addressing the shortage of priests by adding a lay position to lead the parish staff and manage operations. This model allows the pastor to continue in the role as head of the parish, while at the same time, taking administrative tasks off his plate to allow him to focus on serving as pastor."

"I am excited about this new position and the opportunities it will allow me to dive deeper into our faith with my sons and daughters. The first two years of the Beacons of Light process have made it challenging to be present at all five parishes and to get to know parishioners and the churches' cultures as well as I would like," states Fr. Eric. "By adding this new leadership role into our parish family, I pray this will be a huge step in fueling the momentum that we have already begun to achieve through Beacons of Light."

Our Lady of Fatima is pleased to announce the hiring of life-long parishioner Natalie Rohlfs as the Executive Director of Pastoral Services. Natalie is a familiar face to many parishioners and brings a wealth of non-profit, program development, communication and managerial experience to us. She has been a long-time volunteer in many facets of parish life, giving her a well-rounded knowledge of the inner workings of our parish family.

"Looking back, it's now plain for me to see that my heart has been called to this work, his work, for quite a while. After much prayer and many discussions with my family, I'm humbled at this opportunity and honored to serve my church and fellow parishioners through my career. My faith has grown exponentially the last several years – it seems as though it's been his design to prepare me for this line of service," Natalie shared.

Please take time to welcome Natalie into her new role! She will hold office hours in the St. Boniface/St. Mary and St. Patrick offices and will also be present at Transfiguration to work closely with, support and guide the ministry and administrative staff and parish programs. A "staff intro" will follow soon.
