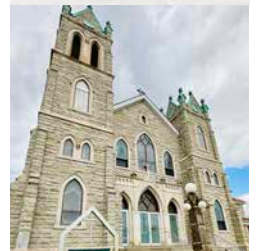

OUR LADY OF FATIMA BEACONS *of* LIGHT CORNER

When Beacons of Light began within Our Lady of Fatima, the decision was thoughtfully made to embed a rotation of our priests to the five churches for weekend Masses. That allowed them to become familiar with not only the newly-defined “family,” but also with each church and to be introduced to its resources, volunteers, parishioners, and even each other’s preferences and styles.

Beginning the weekend of August 31/September 1, Masses for the Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time, Our Lady of Fatima’s priests will begin a two-month rotation at our churches.

There are several reasons for this healthy improvement and this next step in learning how to grow together. The primary reason being that our priests are desiring stronger and more solid relationships to be formed with their parishioners in each city. This should allow time for that to occur and for familiarity to improve. Beyond introductions, they now need to be further acclimated to the rhythm of each parish, including getting to know ushers, servers and liturgical ministers. This will also allow for much simpler schedule tracking and reduced travel between Mass locations and cities, which can become daunting at times in the rush before and after Mass. Finally, there are occasions when their homilies could be semi-continuous to build upon the Gospel readings and what had transpired and had been preached upon the weeks prior. This consistency will provide an opportunity for more effective evangelization through their preaching and Holy Spirit-guided messages.

As we prepare for Phase 3 of the Beacons of Light, just having concluded year two, church leadership, including Pastoral Council, clergy and staff have assessed upcoming needs and next steps regarding this. Other time-length options for this assignment have been properly vetted and discussed, with the two-month rotation being the agreed upon length, initially. Parishioners’ relationships with clergy and our priests’ well-being was the most important part of these discussions.

People from each leadership group have shared comments such as, “If this can be a way we can better protect the mental and physical health of our priests, then why wouldn’t we,” or, “Parishioners might get to visit our other churches more often.”

The first two-month rotation is assigned as follows for September/October:

- St. Boniface/St. Mary | Fr. Eric
- St. Teresa | Fr. Jim
- St. Patrick | Fr. Callan
- Transfiguration | Fr. Steve

Notes:

- This two-month weekend priest rotation model will be through the end of December (two rotations). At that point, the progress and room for improvement will be reassessed.
- Daily Masses (weekdays/Saturday morning) will remain on the normal rotation.
- Confession time at Transfiguration on Saturdays will be shortened due to a lower number of visitors during the first half-hour. Confession will now be 4:00-4:30 p.m. (instead of 3:30 p.m.). Thursday Confessions will remain the same, and hours will extend during Lent and Advent. Contact a priest if you need to schedule a more convenient time.

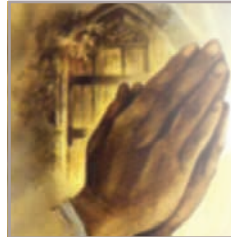
