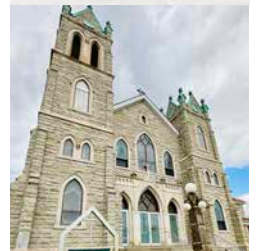

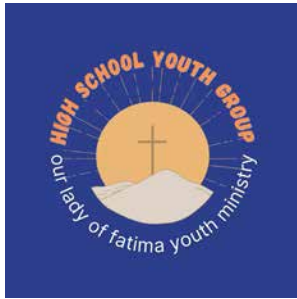

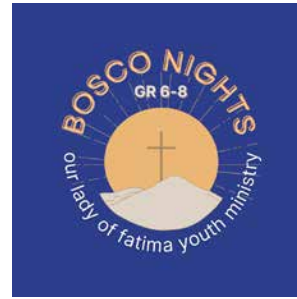

She is also on the committee for the La Leona Center and is a member of the La Leona Weaving cooperative. Both Ted and Maruja participate in a local agricultural co-operative and are key to providing potable water for their neighbors. Ted also works with the community irrigation organization which channels water from three mountain streams to irrigate the farms of 60 peasant farmers. Ted also works with the local beekeepers union. They appreciate the support of the Piqua Parishes Mission Commission.

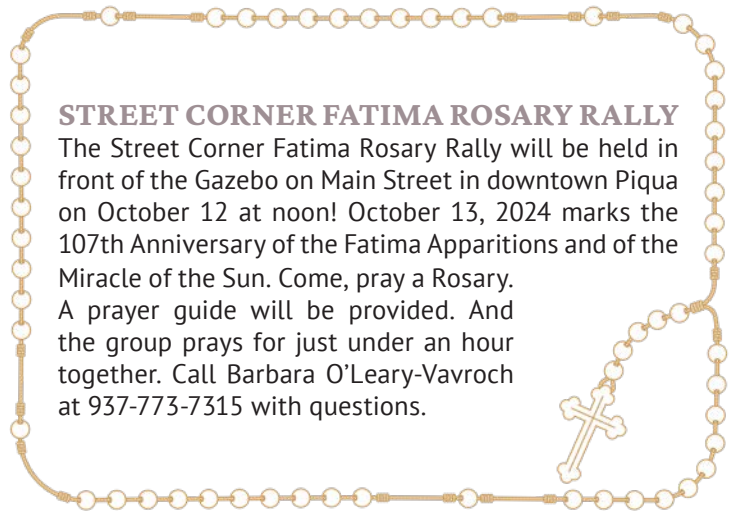
