

**MATRIMONY** Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

**HOMEBOUND** Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

**SAFEPARISH** To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

## FR. ERIC BOWMAN'S RAMBLINGS - WORDS BY POPE JOHN PAUL II ON GAUDETE SUNDAY

I recently came across a homily by Pope St. John Paul II in December of 2000, which I found very insightful and to highlight the joy of this Gaudete Sunday for you. Here are a couple of paragraphs from the homily:

Today, the Third Sunday of Advent, is marked by *joy*: the joy of those awaiting the One who "is at hand," the God-with-us, foretold by the prophets. It is the "*great joy*" of Christmas which we have a foretaste of today; a joy which "will be for all people," because the Saviour came and will come again to visit us from on high, like the rising sun (Lk 1: 78).

It *is the joy of Christians, pilgrims in the world,* who await with hope the glorious return of the One who, to come to our aid, emptied himself of his divine glory. The words of the prophet Zephaniah, which we have just heard in the *first reading,* become particularly eloquent: "Sing aloud, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! The Lord has taken away the judgements against you, he has cast out your enemies" (Zep 3: 14-15): this is the "year of the Lord's favour," which heals us from sin and its wounds!

The prophet's consoling message echoes with great intensity in our assembly: "*The Lord your God is in your midst, a warrior who gives victory; he will rejoice over you with gladness, he will renew you in his love*" (Zep 3: 17).

It is he who *came* and it is he whom we *await*. Our Lord invites us to fix our gaze on him, especially during this Advent of the Year 2000. The Lord, "a warrior who gives victory," is also presented to you today, dear brothers and sisters *who in various ways work in the entertainment world*.

The joy that flows from divine grace *is not a superficial or fleeting happiness*. It is a deep joy, rooted in the heart, which can imbue the believer's entire life. A joy that can coexist with difficulties, trials, even – however paradoxical this may seem – with pain and death. It is the joy of Christmas and Easter, the gift of the incarnate Son of God, who died and rose again; a joy that no one can take from those who are one with him in faith and works.

#### **BETHANY CENTER**

December is St. Mary's month for donations to the Bethany Center Food Pantry. Bethany Center clients are especially in need of canned meat, fish, vegetables, soups, stew and fruit. Other items needed are spaghetti, pasta sauce, fruit juice, broth, gravy,

peanut butter, breakfast cereal, mac'n cheese, jelly, pancake mix, syrup, boxed dinners, instant potatoes, noodles, popcorn and corn bread mix.
