

## FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – STATIONS OF THE CROSS

If you are attending Mass on the third, fourth and fifth Sunday of Lent, you may find an additional rite added to those Masses, known as the scrutinies. The scrutinies are part of the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) process for those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. They take place during the period of OCIA formation known as Purification and Enlightenment, near the end of their formation.

The season of Lent involves a more intense period of examination and preparation for the Candidates and Elect, and, hopefully, for those of us already living the Catholic faith. Though they are meant for the OCIA Candidates and Elect, the Scrutinies can help all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion. The purpose of the Scrutinies is to "*uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful*" in the hearts of the Elect and to "*strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.*"

Though the word "scrutinize" sounds negative, even intimidating, its true meaning is simply "to see clearly or inspect closely." The Scrutinies are about seeing sin in its right aspect, and coming to understand the way we fall victim to it. They are also about the transformative healing possible for us through Christ, as He offers Himself to us.

Once we see sin for what it really is, and better understand our own personal weaknesses, we can begin to exercise the freedom and liberation we have received through Jesus. With God's grace, we can turn away from the darkness of sin, reject disordered patterns, and step into the light. This is possible for us because we believe in the redemptive sacrifice of Christ, and we entrust ourselves to Him.

The Scrutinies are associated with three specific Gospel stories on the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent:

- Jesus encountering the Samaritan woman at the well, where He offers Himself as the Living Water
- Jesus healing the man born blind, where He gives Himself as Light of the World
- Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, where He reveals Himself as the Resurrection and the Life.



Daily Masses (weekdays/Saturday morning) will remain the same.


# 9 Months With Christ in the WOMB

March: Mary's First Moments with Jesus | Luke 1:26-37

At the beginning of time, God the Father had spoken the words, "Let there be light," and so it had come to be. The Word of God made flesh is conceived and brought into the world of creation through the words of a teenage girl – Mary said, "Let it be done to me according to your word." He comes, not as a conquering king, not as a noble child, not even as the infant in swaddling clothes. He comes, first and foremost, in the form of a single, fragile cell of humanity, wrapped securely inside the warmth of His mother's body.

He is so small that, even if He were not inside His mother's womb, He would not be identifiable to the naked eye. Yet, He is already wholly and utterly the God-man, destined to save all of humanity through His love and His sacrifice. This time is preserved such that only His mother can share the precious time with Him. Mary turns her thoughts to other women who have found themselves pregnant and alone. She thought of Joseph, her betrothed – Would he understand? Would he still want to marry her? She hoped he would, but she trusted that God would provide whatever was needed. She began offering up prayers for the other women who have felt lost and desperate in pregnancy. Other girls in circumstances like hers might feel deeply alone. Throughout this next month, please pray especially for women in crisis pregnancies.

Solemnity: The Annunciation of the Lord celebrates the coming of the Angel Gabriel, to the Virgin Mary to announce to her the special mission God had chosen for her in being the mother of His only son. It's celebrated on March 25, nine months before Christmas, and marks the beginning of Jesus' human life. A solemnity is a feast day of the highest rank in the Catholic Church, celebrating a mystery of faith such as the Trinity, an event in the life of Jesus, the Blessed Virgin Mary or important saints. The faithful are permitted to celebrate on solemnities without Lenten promises or fasting during those days. (March 25 is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but daily Mass is still available according to the normal Mass schedule and an additional Mass will be hosted at St. Patrick in the evening.
