Millions of men, women and children worldwide are coerced or forced through human trafficking that the Holy Father has called "a crime against humanity." As part of its mission to proclaim Christ's salvation and to restore and promote the dignity of all persons, the Church is called to combat trafficking and to bring comfort and healing to its victims.

The Department of Migration and Refugee Services (MRS) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops carries out this mission through two anti-trafficking, anti-slavery programs. The "Become a Shepherd" program is a parish-based awareness campaign that educates lay and religious leaders to recognize human trafficking and combat it through public engagement and advocacy at the community level. The second initiative, COMPASS (Coalition of Organizations and Ministries Promoting the Abolition of Slavery at Sea) is a global effort in which international Catholic and non-Catholic partners coordinate to identify and assist victims of modern slavery encountered in the commercial fishing and seafood-processing industries.

The invaluable work to assist these victims of abuse and injustice is supported by funds received through The Catholic Relief Services Collection. Your participation helps reveal Christ's love to victims of trafficking, war, and natural disaster both around the world and here in the United States. A collection will be taken the weekend of Sunday, May 4.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY IS APRIL 27. Beautiful Liturgies, Eucharistic Adoration, Confession, Chaplet and Prayers will be part of the celebration of the Divine Mercy at:

Church of the Transfiguration | 12:00 - 3:15 p.m.

In a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, Our Lord called for a special feast day to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Today, we know that feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by Pope St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

In all, St. Faustina recorded 14 revelations from Jesus concerning His desire for this feast. The Lord expressed His will with regard to the feast in His very first revelation to her. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her Diary (699):

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine floodgates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy."

Indeed Divine Mercy, it is not primarily about St. Faustina, nor is it altogether a new feast. The Second Sunday of Easter was already a solemnity as the Octave Day of Easter. * The title "Divine Mercy Sunday" highlights the meaning of the day. (Reference: thedivinemercy.org)

*Liturgically, the Easter Octave has always been centered on the theme of Divine Mercy and forgiveness. Divine Mercy Sunday, therefore, points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the whole Paschal Mystery – the whole mystery of the death, burial and Resurrection of Christ – made present for us in the Eucharist. In this way, it also sums up the whole Easter Octave.

A plenary indulgence can be obtained on the Feast of Divine Mercy.

- As stated in the 2002 decree, this can be done by going to a church on Divine Mercy Sunday "in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin," and participating in the prayers held in honor of Divine Mercy. Those practices could consist of devotions such as the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Eucharistic Adoration and the Sacrament of Confession.
- The faithful could also visit the Blessed Sacrament either exposed or in the tabernacle and recite the Our Father, the Nicene Creed and a devout prayer to Christ. The example of a devout prayer that is given in the decree is *"Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!"*

In order to receive the indulgence, the three usual conditions must also be met:

- Go to Confession.*
- Receive Holy Communion.
- Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.
- Venerate the image of the Divine Mercy.


*The Church permits the Sacrament up to 20 days before/after the day.




