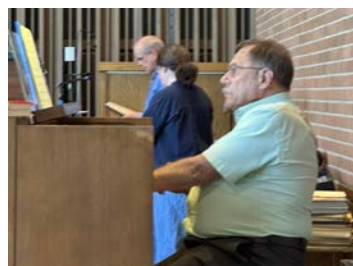
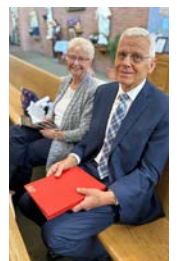
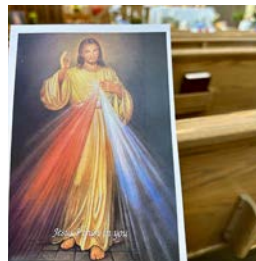


CHRIST IN THE WOMB

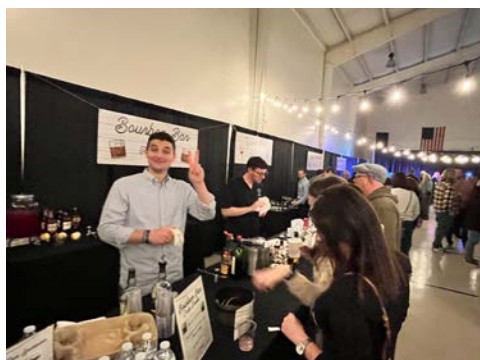
