FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – A YOUTH MINISTRY THANKS

The month of May always brings such joy and hope as we witness our trees and flower beds blooming, birds chirping and singing a bit louder and the sunny warm days returning. In the life and rhythm of the church, the month of May brings First Communions, May Crownings, graduations, and, sadly, a closeout to our annual youth programs.

This past year, we have been without a youth minister. As a result, several members of our parish community stepped up to ensure that our youth had a great year! Our group of volunteers/staff dedicated to this ministry ranges from a priest, a seminarian, staff, teachers, volunteers, parents, young adults and even high school seniors. I would like to take this opportunity and personally thank these amazing people.

First of all, I need to thank Natalie Rohlfs, Executive Director of Pastoral Services, who took on what amounted to a second full-time job in overseeing all of our junior and senior high youth groups and Confirmation preparation. Countless hours were poured in by Natalie. She regularly coordinated with the team of 17 catechists and parents to provide the best formation possible for our young people, so they wouldn't miss a year of programming.

Those who taught our Catholic school Confirmation and 7th/8th grade CCD classes and dedicated their time to our students' religious education included: Matt and Sheila Enneking, Eric Wehrley, Wendy Fisher, Jaci Taylor, Heather Smith and Louis Gaier, and special volunteers as well, including Katie Sedlack and Sara Gudorf. Thank you so much.

Next, would be Fr. Callan, who agreed to run the high school youth group along with his core team of young adults each Sunday night. Fr. Callan and his team did a great job of balancing beautiful opportunities for prayer and Adoration with deep teachings on the faith, and, of course, LOTS of time for food, friends and games! Thank you so much Fr. Callan and the HSYG team, which included Louis Gaier, Grace Dexter, Tara Gerding and Dan Pearson.

Finally, I would like to acknowledge Deanna Rohlfs, a senior at Troy High School who agreed to form a team to run Bosco Nights – our junior high youth group, 6th-8th graders. Imagine being a senior in high school and your pastor calls you into his office to ask you to invest heavily in running the junior high youth nights. This past fall on a Tuesday afternoon I met with Deanna, and she agreed on the spot to head up a Bosco team so that our students could have a fruitful year. The team grew to include two other high school seniors, Bailey Cooper and Brooke Householder, along with Jaci Taylor and her brother Dylan Taylor and our seminarian intern Bao Duong. This Bosco team did an amazing job in building a fun, prayerful and deeply spiritual environment for our young people. I am so incredibly proud of the leadership demonstrated by Deanna, who, by the way, will now become a full-time missionary at Damascus Catholic Mission Campus. We wish her, and all of our seniors, luck, and we promise to cover them in prayer.

As we move forward in building the Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes staff and thoughtfully filling the roles it takes to coordinate the five churches and a growing community, I ask that you join in prayer, specifically, that the person who God wants in the capacity of youth minister may be led to us soon. Join Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes in Honor of Memorial Day







Pope Leo XIV was born September 14, 1955, in Chicago, Illinois. He holds a bachelor's degree from the Augustinian-run Villanova University in Pennsylvania and joined the order in 1977, making his solemn vows in 1981.

He joined the Augustinian mission in Peru in 1985 and largely worked in the country until 1999 when he was elected head of the Augustinians' Chicago-based province. From 2001 to 2013, he served as prior general of the worldwide order. In 2015, Pope Francis named him bishop of Chiclayo, in northern Peru, and the pope asked him also to be apostolic administrator of Callao, Peru, from April 2020 to May 2021.

Pope Francis elevated him to Cardinal in the Consistory of September 30, 2023, when he was assigned Cardinal of St. Monica. On February 6, 2025, Pope Francis promoted him to the highest degree of Cardinals, granting him the title of the Suburbicarian Church of Albano.

On May 8, 2025, Cardinal Protodeacon Dominique Mamberti pronounced the formula, "Habemus Papam," proclaiming to the city of Rome and to the whole world the news of the election of Robert Francis Cardinal Prevost as Pope Leo XIV.


