#### CATHOLICISM EXPLAINED

June 22, 2025 marks the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the celebration of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. During this celebration, we encounter a unique liturgical phenomenon called a *Sequence*. Sung between the Second Reading and the Alleluia, **the Sequence is a sacred poem set to music which proclaims a teaching of the Church relating to the feast day on which it is sung.** Dating to the medieval period, this musical meditation incorporates the teachings of the Church on the Eucharist into the Mass in an artistically meaningful way.

The Sequence may be sung in Latin or English. If sung in Latin, we have the opportunity to listen to the mystery of the melody and to hear an ancient message proclaimed in the Catholic Western Latin Rite Church's "national" language. In English, the meaning of the message comes alive in the vernacular, the domestic language of the country in which it is proclaimed. Vatican II opened the Novus Ordo (New Order) Mass up to use of the vernacular. During this time, one of the Vatican II reforms was to decrease the number of mandatory Sequences to be sung throughout the year. The Sequences at Easter and last week's Pentecost are mandatory. The Sequence on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, like the Sequence on the Solemnity of Our Lady of Sorrows, is optional.

The Sequence for Corpus Christi, titled "Lauda, Sion, Salvatorem" was written by St. Thomas Aquinas. Translated into English, the first words of the Sequence ring out as "Praise, O Zion, Your Salvation." In other words, the Sequence calls God's people to embrace their true identity, symbolized by the city of Jerusalem or Zion, and to give thanks for the salvation they possess through Jesus Christ. From there, the Sequence unfolds to reveal more reasons for praise and hope in the Body and Blood of Christ as well as the mystery and life unfolded for those who partake of the heavenly feast at Mass.

The best way to receive the full impact of the poem would be to read it outside of the Mass as content for meditation. Oftentimes, it can be hard to understand what is being said as it's sung, even in English. Sitting with the meaning of the words will help it to come alive within us and for us to be made alive by it. As these ancient and lively words ring out over our churches during this sacred season, let us stay awake to the meaning of their message and the enduring connection they offer in each age to any soul who hears it sung.

Bad and good the feast are sharing, Of what divers dooms preparing, Endless death, or endless life.


Life to these, to those damnation, See how like participation Is with unlike issues rife.


