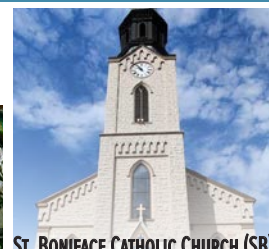

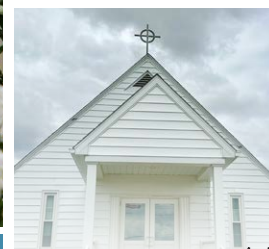

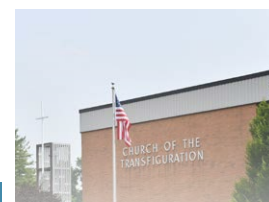

Our Lady of Fatima's Mass and Confession schedules will adjust beginning Monday, June 30, 2025. Thanks to our current priests, there will still be 11 opportunities for Sunday obligation Masses within Our Lady of Fatima's Family of Parishes, please plan your Mass attendance accordingly and help others know the information.

Multiple configurations were reviewed and considered by clergy, staff, Pastoral Council, the leadership team and the Deanery of the Archdiocese with several factors, requirements and schedules having been in motion. Thank you for your patience and kindness when adjustments occur. We are very grateful for the people who were involved and represented our parishes not only through this process, but also to those who have participated so thoughtfully for these first three years of Beacons of Light.

Question: I've been seeing the word "Vigil" in our schedules. What is a "Vigil?"

Answer: A Vigil is when Mass is celebrated the evening prior (3:00 p.m. +) to Sunday Masses (and Holy Days of Obligation)

The daily Mass schedule will remain the same, except for the following:

- Monday Mass at St. Boniface will now be at 12:10 p.m.
- No daily Mass at St. Teresa on Wednesday or Thursday.
