Question: I've been seeing the word "Vigil" in our schedules. What is a "Vigil?" **Answer:** A Vigil is when Mass is celebrated the evening prior (3:00 p.m. +) to Sunday Masses (and Holy Days of Obligation)

The daily Mass schedule will remain the same, except for the following:

- Monday Mass at St. Boniface will now be at 12:10 p.m.
- No daily Mass at St. Teresa on Wednesday or Thursday.
