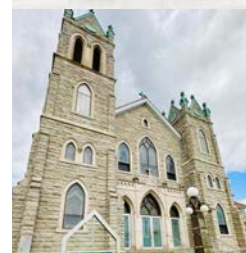

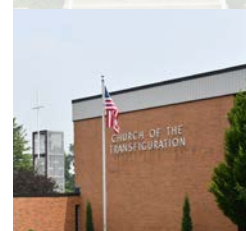

FR. ERIC'S RAMBLINGS – PENTECOST SUNDAY

Pentecost Sunday marks a pivotal moment in Christian history, commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and other followers of Jesus, as described in the Book of Acts (Acts 2). It's celebrated 50 days after Easter, signifying the birth of the Church and the beginning of its mission to the world. In the first chapter of the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus tells the disciples to stay in Jerusalem and, *"To wait there for the promise of the Father. This is what you have heard from me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."* (Acts 1:4-5) In fact, just nine days later the apostles received the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the upper room. But even before this "gift" of the Spirit, Jesus tells the apostles why they are going to receive the Holy Spirit.

In Acts 1:8, Jesus states, *"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and the ends of all the earth."* These are the last words Jesus spoke to his disciples/apostles before he ascended into the clouds from their sight. They contain a truth and a power that will transform the minds and hearts of the apostles carrying them out on mission to wherever the Holy Spirit sends them. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, they won't just preach the Good News, rather they will BECOME the Good News.

This is the destiny of all Christians. We are meant to be transformed by the Gospel message so that our very lives become the testimony others may need in order to believe in and become a follower of Jesus Christ. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we, like the apostles, can receive the courage and strength to boldly speak to others about God's love for them. We can humbly and fearlessly live the great commandment, *"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age."* Matthew 28: 19-20

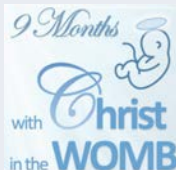

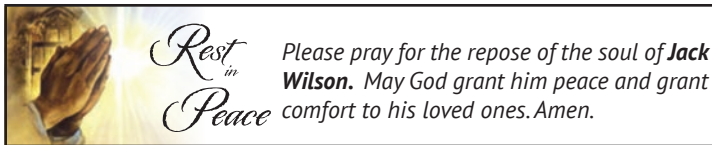

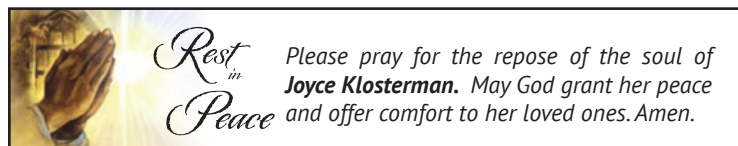
