BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!*

Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your required Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org, 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Pastoral Council typically meets for an hour once per month, approximately nine or ten months per year. The term limit is typically three years with consideration for renewal.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN'S RAMBLINGS – MASS INTENTIONS

MASS INTENTIONS ARE NOW ABLE TO BE ACCEPTED FOR BEYOND JULY 1!

We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God. (CCC 1032 – *This refers to Canon Law.*)

The Catholic Church requires one Mass Intention each weekend to be said for the “Living and Deceased” of a particular parish. However, in the case of a region (or family of parishes), then, only ONE Intention is required for all the parishes. Therefore, a Mass Intention for the “Living and Deceased of Our Lady of Fatima” will soon be held:



- 5:00 p.m. at St. Patrick – 1st and 5th Sundays
- 9:15 a.m. at St. Mary – 2nd Sunday
- 3:30 p.m. at St. Boniface – 3rd Sunday
- 7:30 a.m. at Transfiguration – 4th Sunday

In order to accommodate the loss of Masses at St. Teresa and Transfiguration, it's been taken into special account to add “Purgatorian Mass Intentions,” for each of the following Masses, accepting up to five Purgatorian Mass Intentions.

- 7:30 a.m. St. Teresa – 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays
- 8:15 a.m. Transfiguration – Wednesdays

A Purgatorian Mass Intention is specifically offered for the souls in purgatory for our deceased brothers and sisters. Fr. Steve will share and teach more about that next week! The second and fourth Sunday of each month, (and the fifth, when that occurs) will be held for other Mass Intentions, such as honoring someone for a birthday or anniversary.

Intention Guidelines:

1. A maximum of ten (10) announced Mass Intentions per year from any one individual may be scheduled.
2. No more than one (1) Intention per non-Purgatorian Mass. Purgatorian Masses may have up to (5) five Intentions noted in total reserved by the faithful.
3. Intention requests will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis with a \$5 gift per Intention (as defined by the AOC) payable at the church office.

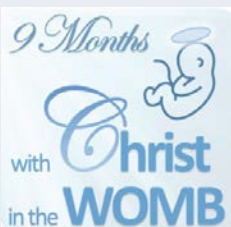
