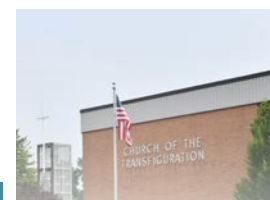

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!*

Class is required, by appointment. Prior to baptizing your child, register for your required Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org, 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOIDTING OF THE SICK

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE SAFE ENVIRONMENT OFFICE

A reminder regarding the Decree on Child Protection that all employees and volunteers are required to have completed the Archdiocese of Cincinnati SafeParish™: Protecting Children From Sexual Abuse. Ohio Department of Education licensees may have additional requirements, and school offices or athletic departments should be consulted if there are questions. Volunteers are required to complete an online background check prior to volunteering with youth. Employees and volunteers are required to stay current in completing SafeParish™ quarterly training bulletins. With the school year beginning, please make sure you are up-to-date on training completion or you unfortunately will not be able to work/volunteer with youth until that's done. FR. ERIC BOWMAN RAMBLINGS

75th Anniversary Celebration of the Church of the Transfiguration

On Sunday August 27, 1950 the Church of the Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ was dedicated by the the Most Reverend George Rehring. The Church of the Transfiguration has stood as a beacon of faithfulness to God and His Word for the past 75 years. I asked that Fr. John McQuarrie share a short reflection on his time as pastor of Transfiguration.

"Seventy-five years of God's grace and blessing is no small thing. Transfiguration Church and its people have certainly meant that for me. I have so many good memories of loving and caring people, some now gone to their Eternal Reward, who enriched my ministry as a priest and pastor. I've learned over the years that each parish I have been associated with have blessed me in unique ways. Transfiguration stands out above all for many reasons. A very good friend of mine, Fr. Jim Willig, told me at the time that the very name of the church would mean that it was a place of growth, challenge, much opportunity and transformation in my calling as a priest. When I received the call of Bishop Moeddel asking me to move to West Milton, I never dreamed in a million years I would be asked to oversee the building of a priest's retirement community, retreat/conference center and nature preserve! All, of course, due to Kathryn Lange who blessed our parish in her will after she went to the Lord. Our God is a God of surprises! So many hard working parishioners supported me in that most amazing gift. I can only say with St. Peter up on Mount Tabor as he saw the Transfiguration of Jesus with apostles James and John, 'Master, it is good that we are here.' I pray for all of you that through our Catholic Faith in Word and Sacrament, we grow ever more in love with God and one another."

As I reflect on my own 11 years as pastor, I feel humbled to follow in the footsteps of such holy priests. I have spoken many times about my deep love and respect for Fr. John and Fr. Charlie and how much they have helped me grow as a "spiritual father." But I also would like to thank the holy people of Transfiguration for helping my faith in our Blessed Mother grow. The love of Mary is so evident in Transfiguration. As we look forward to another 75 plus years, I pray that the people of Transfiguration Church will continue to remain firm in her commitment to Our Lord and united to Mary, our mother.

Fr. John and I look forward to celebrating the 75th Anniversary with parishioners and visitors on August 24, 2025 beginning with 10:00 a.m. Mass and the cake and punch reception after!

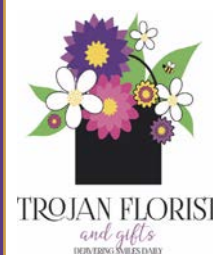
