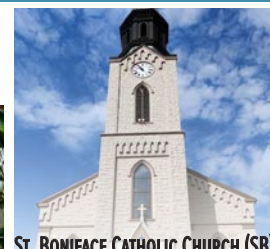

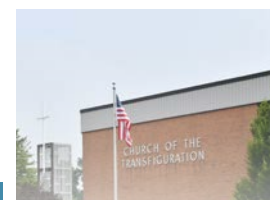

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!*

Class is required, by appointment. Prior to baptizing your child, register for your required Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org, 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOIDING OF THE SICK

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

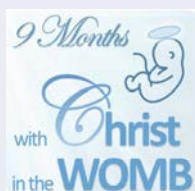

Introduction to a Consecration to Mary

Our Family of Parishes will hold its second Fatima Day Mass on Sunday, September 28 at 11:30 a.m. at the Lange Estate! Archbishop Robert Casey granted us permission to celebrate the Mass of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. As part of this Marian celebration, I would like to offer the opportunity for everyone to make a consecration to Our Lady of Fatima.

A Marian consecration is a personal act of devotion where an individual dedicates himself/herself to the Blessed Virgin Mary, entrusting his/her life to her motherly guidance and intercession in order to grow closer to Jesus. It's a way of imitating Christ, who came through Mary, by going through her to reach God. St. Louis de Montfort wrote and preached on the phrase, "to Jesus through Mary." Mary's "yes" to the Archangel Gabriel, paved the way for our Salvation. The flesh and blood that her Son, Christ, poured out on the cross was from her body. Her last recorded words in the Gospel of John, "Do whatever he tells you," point us toward her mission, which is to bring all of humanity to Jesus. These are just a few of the reasons we should consecrate ourselves to her Immaculate Heart, her maternal love.

Over the next few bulletin articles we will explore different aspects of OLF that can aid us in our consecration. We will look at the spirituality of the children of Fatima, the messages from Our Lady, and her promise made on July 13, 1917 that, "In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph."



CHRIST IN THE WOMB

Weeks 22 & 23 – Jesus is moving around a lot, as if He is an exercise enthusiast. Mary loves the sensation, knowing that these are the earliest moments in which any human being is getting to feel the physical presence of God! He now has a sense of balance and can tell whether He is upside or right-side up, and spends the majority of His time right-side up. *Jesus of the womb, hear our prayers!*

FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE SAFE ENVIRONMENT OFFICE

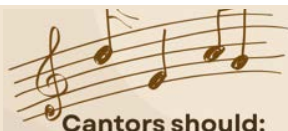

COMING SOON TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA...

Beginning the weekend of September 6 and 7, 2025, Our Lady of Fatima (OLF) will transition to using worship aids as the primary music resource in our pews. OLF is transitioning to worship aids to allow our musicians the ability to travel between Mass times, churches and choirs without the struggle of switching between hymnals that have different lyrics, keyboard accompaniments and numbers. This switch also allows our churches to grow closer together by sharing the best parts of each of their music programs in one, unified resource. Questions about this transition are natural, so here are answers to some of the most common:

Does this mean we'll never use the hymnals in our pews again?

No. Churches with hardbound hymnals will continue to use their books for the weekly readings. Churches that use a Missalette will use a readings-only Missalette for weekly readings.

Aren't worship aids expensive to print every week?

No. The decision to transition to worship aids comes after a careful study of the cost-benefit analysis of each music resource option. Worship aids will save OLF thousands of dollars each year over a yearly Missalette subscription or the investment cost of a hardbound hymnal.

Are the hymnals at each church really that different?

Yes! There are substantial differences between the four hymnals used in each of Our Lady Fatima's churches. Not only are different sets of songs included in each book, but major changes that exist between each edition. Even classics like "Immaculate Mary" can have anywhere from four to seven verses depending on the hymnal. This coupled with a completely different organ part for each hymn means a lot of juggling for our rotating musicians. The 7:30 a.m. Mass at St. Teresa and the 11:30 a.m. Mass at St. Patrick will not need worship aids at this time, since resources will still be in the pews to support the musicians of those Masses.

I still don't understand why we're making this change...

An important goal of the Beacons of Light process is the unification of OLF's staff and programs. Part of this goal means sharing our musicians between churches. By transitioning to one unified resource for hymns, we alleviate a great deal of confusion for our musicians. Now, organists and choirs can know what to expect when they serve at Masses, concerts, special events, weddings and funerals in OLF.

What do I do with the Worship aid at the end of Mass?

So that subsequent Masses may use the worship aids and so to alleviate clean up for our ushers, please return them near the door as you exit.

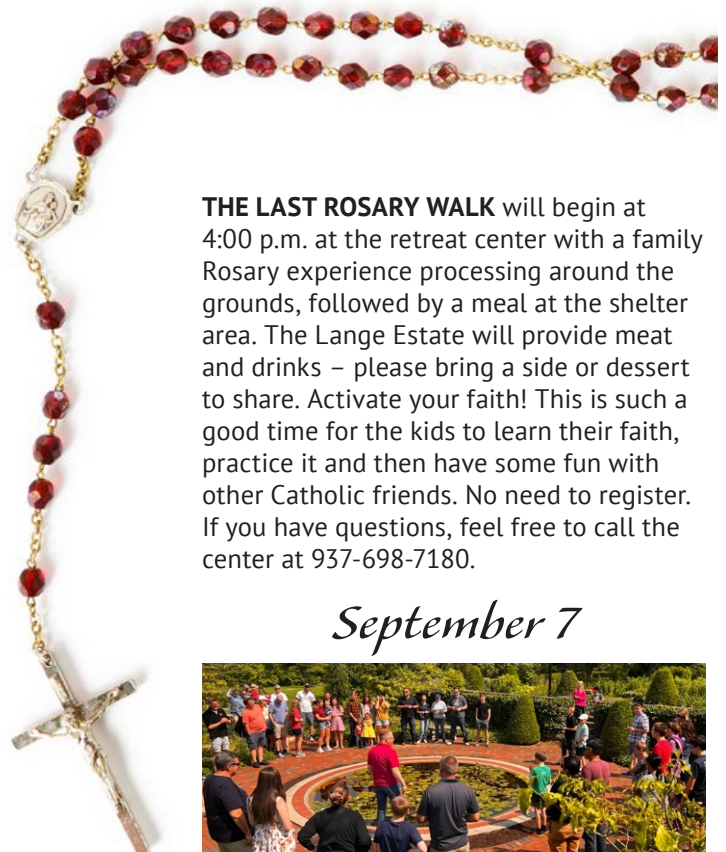
