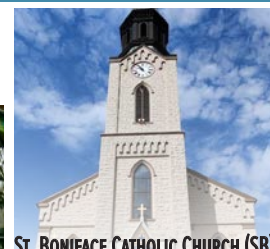

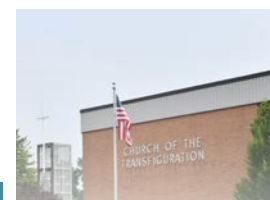

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!*

Class is required, by appointment. Prior to baptizing your child, register for your required Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org, 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Pastoral Council typically meets for an hour once per month, approximately nine or ten months per year. The term limit is typically three years with consideration for renewal.

Mary, Image of the Church & The First Disciple



Fatima Day - September 28, 2025 OUR CONSECRATION TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

There are so many beautiful titles given to our Blessed Mother. There are two litanies that focus on the names of Mary. The names "Image of the Church" and "The First Disciple" are both related. Her complete commitment to God's will, her faith and her charity exemplify the ideal Christian life. She is the first and truest disciple of her Son.

Ahead of our Consecration to Our Lady of Fatima on Fatima Day, let's briefly explore Mary as "Image of the Church." The Catechism highlights Mary's perfect faith and charity in her response to God's will, making her a model of complete adherence to God's plan. Catechism 967 states, "By her complete adherence to the Father's will, to his Son's redemptive work, and to every prompting of the Holy Spirit, the Virgin Mary is the Church's model of faith and charity. Thus she is a 'preeminent and ...wholly unique member of the Church.' Indeed, she is the 'exemplary realization' of the Church." She is "The First Disciple," demonstrating how to serve and follow her Son with humble obedience, rooted in faith, and beginning with her "yes" to Archangel Gabriel. She continued to demonstrate this obedience even to her participation in the suffering and death of Jesus. By standing at the foot of the cross, Mary demonstrated strength, faith and the ability to endure suffering while remaining focused on the Lord.

As we continue our journey to our Consecration to Our Lady of Fatima, may we draw upon her example of obedience in our lives to God's Word and His Church. May we follow Mary's example of faith, as we, too, echo the refrain: "Let it be done to me according to your word." And finally, may we always be found standing next to Our Lady at the foot of the cross of our salvation.

The St. Patrick Soup Kitchen!

The St. Patrick Soup Kitchen, a stand-alone 501(c)(3) nonprofit, has been serving families in need since 1994. Founded by its Executive Director, Dick Steineman, the kitchen provides nightly meals and serves as a gathering place for local nonprofits. As a United Way Member Agency, it partners with the community to lift up those in need. Following its original and longstanding partnership with St. Patrick Catholic Church, where it originally was housed, the St. Patrick Soup Kitchen moved in 2014, and is operating around the corner from the church in their beautiful Hobart Community Kitchen at 25 N. Mulberry Street. Their doors are always open on the Water Street side of the building for community members to place refrigerated or shelf-stable food and supply donations. Thank you to those who bless our community and who show Catholic love in action by sharing, serving, donating, praying for and volunteering with The St. Patrick Soup Kitchen.
