

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN RAMBLINGS

Mary's Role in Our Spiritual Life



We have been preparing to make a Consecration to Our Lady of Fatima. In this consecration to Our Lady, we are welcoming her motherly love and care for our eternal soul. Like Mary, we are saying our "YES" to God's call for holiness in our lives and the lives of those we love so tenderly. We turn our attention to two Biblical stories to examine Mary's role in our lives.

We begin with the Wedding Feast of Cana found in John 2: "On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to me and to you? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." In this beautiful story, we find two important aspects of this role. The first is that she brings our problems, struggles, concerns and brokenness to her Son. The second key aspect is she not only teaches us to listen to her Son, but she commands us to listen to Him, for she knows it is the only path of salvation.

And for our second Biblical story, we stay in John's Gospel with the crucifixion of Jesus. John 19:25-27: "Meanwhile, standing near the cross of Jesus were his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom He loved standing beside her, He said to His mother, "Woman, here is your son." Then He said to the disciple, "Here is your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his own home." Jesus, with His dying breath, took the time to give Mary as our mother. Not just symbolically, or not just spiritually, but in every aspect of motherhood. Mary is our true mother and she loves us with the singular grace, reserved solely for Mary, with the same passion she loves her Son.

MENTAL WELLNESS FOR THE FAITHFUL

Peace be with you. God grants us a beautiful opportunity this week to honor even the small things - things that seem meaningless sometimes, or things we question why we even do them or why we put so much energy into them. For example, keeping the house clean and organized in a house that is filled with children (and chaos), or going that extra step to make a good meal great. The comfort from God comes in the words, "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones." This scripture might also help us to recall the passage, "To those who have, more will be given." Thus, God deeply values our commitment to and engagement in love as we complete the small tasks of life. In turn, in cooperation with Mother Teresa's words, be comforted in your commitment to doing "small things with great love," because He sees these things matter to Him. And, when we commit to doing even the small things with great love, to the best of our ability, for the positive benefit of another, we will be deemed trustworthy by the One who sees all things, never forgets "a thing they have done," and our reward shall be great in heaven.





"Life Chain" will be Sunday, October 5, from 2:00-3:00 p.m. near the Courthouse on West Main Street in Troy.


