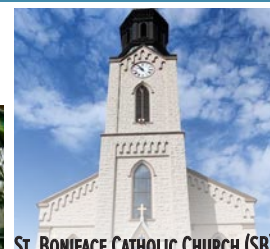

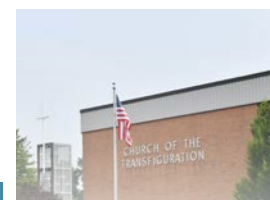

Class is required, by appointment. Prior to baptizing your child, register for your required Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org, 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY

Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOIDTING OF THE SICK

Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND

Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH

To volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

OCTOBER 19: FEAST DAY OF THE NORTH AMERICAN MARTYRS

During the 17th century, six priests and two laymen from the Jesuit order set out on a heroic mission to teach the natives of North America about Jesus Christ. They stood with bravery in the face of suffering, and they were viciously tortured and killed. They are remembered as the "North American Martyrs."

On October 19, Catholics remember these eight men who sacrificed their lives to spread our faith. They are priests **St. John de Brebeuf**, **St. Antony Daniel**, **St. Charles Garnier**, **St. Isaac Jogues**, **St. Gabriel Lalemant**, **St. Noël Chabanel** and oblates **St. René Goupil** and **St. John de Lalande**. Many people warned the group of men of the dangers that lay ahead. The territory they went to evangelize, then called "New France," was an extremely hostile environment. There was rampant disease, food shortage, a severe climate and isolation. In addition to those circumstances was the hostile population, who had no qualms about using tools of torture.

They traveled across the ocean with God-given zeal to preach the Gospel to the Native Americans who had never heard the Good News of our faith. They taught primarily to the Huron, but were raided by the brutal Iroquois people. Each of the North American Martyrs deserves his own article, but they were all tied together with one mission: to proclaim the Gospel. However, I would like to highlight one of them.

St. John de Brebeuf's skills as an evangelist were evident. He was gifted in languages and quickly learned the Huron traditions and customs. He often would help the other missionaries learn the language so they could be more effective in communicating Christ's teachings. When the Iroquois people invaded the Huron, they captured several of the Jesuits. They were imprisoned for more than a year by the tribe and forced to watch as the Huron were tortured, mangled and ripped apart while still alive. He was an extremely large man, in which they had to build a special canoe big enough to carry him up and down the river. When he was killed, he was known as the "greatest warrior" of the black robes (name given to Jesuits because of the cassock). He was treated with extra cruelty because of this.

St. John de Brebeuf prayed, "My God and my Savior Jesus, what return can I make to you for all the benefits you have conferred on me? I make a vow to you never to fail, on my side, in the grace of martyrdom, if by your infinite mercy you offer it to me some day." When St. John de Brebeuf was about to die, he looked at the Huron people beside him and said, "God is the witness of our sufferings, and will soon be our exceeding great reward. Let us die in this faith...Sustain with courage the few remaining torments. They will end our lives. The glory which follows them will never have an end."

North American Martyrs, pray for us.

GENEROUS HANDS, GENEROUS HEART STEVE KINDER – ST. BONIFACE

Steve Kinder, a retired Navy cook who served from 1965–1969 during the Vietnam War, has been a St. Boniface parishioner for six years. Originally from Tipp City, Steve spent time living in the Smoky Mountains before settling in Piqua with his wife, Nancy.

When asked what he enjoys most about St. Boniface, Steve shared, “I like Fr. Eric – he always shakes my hand and thanks me. Fr. Dan and Fr. Tom were good to me, too.” Steve recalls a special connection with Fr. Eric after both experienced heart scares during Mass at different times.

Grateful for the kindness of parishioners who have brought him supplies, Steve has also found ways to give back. He repairs and donates Rosaries – never charging for his work. “I also send them (Rosaries) to the troops because they don’t get much,” he says. “I leave some for Theresa (Henderson) to have blessed by our priests and to make available to parishioners.” Steve has also sent items to mission churches in Michigan and Virginia.

His ministry began when he was living in North Carolina, and he mentioned to Fr. Boyd of St. Francis of Assisi in Franklin that he was feeling bored. “So he set me up with Our Lady of the Rosary, and that started it all,” Steve recalls. Now, whenever someone drops off a religious item in need of repair, Theresa gives Steve a call.

“I go to Mass every Saturday evening, and people come talk to me about it,” Steve says. “I haven’t had a Rosary yet that I couldn’t repair... and I never give them back unblessed.”

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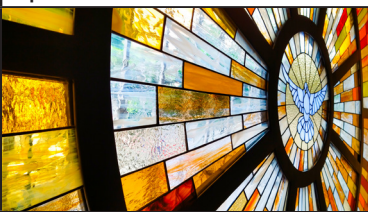
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
