MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

I am happy to report progress with our major church projects. The St. Boniface's HVAC system is functional in the church, with additional heating for the bathrooms and baseboard heating for the chapel also being addressed, in addition to the air condition work. The St. Patrick's Phase II capital repair to the church steps, despite the cold season, has moved forward. The stair walls and the backfill for the steps are completed. The new radiant snow-melt system will begin next. The work will continue for several more weeks on both projects, but it is wonderful to see and feel the momentum. We have been well pleased with the vendors that we are partnering with.

Speaking of projects, I am proud to announce that the new organ and the new bells system in the bell tower are both installed and working well at St. Mary. Thank you to everyone involved in making both of these projects happen. We will be dedicating the organ at the 9:15 a.m. Mass this Sunday and honoring Linda Richard's 24+ years of service to St. Mary Catholic Church and her people. Linda retired on January 1, and she looks forward to spending more time with her family, especially all of her grandkids. I am so beyond grateful for my time with Linda these past three and half years. Her professionalism and her joyful spirit were experienced by all who came in contact with her. Thank Linda for her time, energy and love poured out for the people of St. Mary!

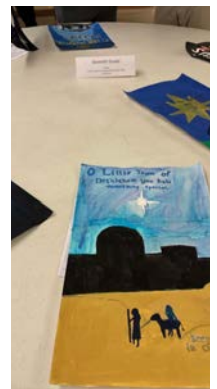


