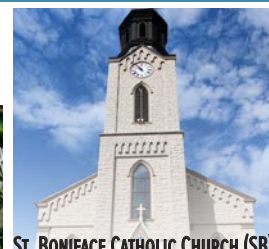

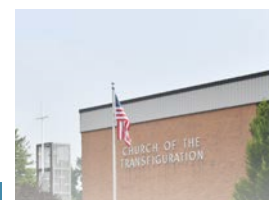

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANointing OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

Converted by Love: A Reflection on the Conversion of St. Paul

"It is with trembling that St. Paul recalls his vocation: 'And last of all, as by one born out of due time, he was seen also by me. For I am the least of the apostles, and am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God.' Thus writes Saul of Tarsus, whose personality and drive fill history with awe." (St. Josemaria Escriva)

The conversion of St. Paul is one of the more defining moments in the history of the Church, for God called to Himself One who stands as a model for the universal call to conversion. It highlights God's power to change hearts, redefine purpose and reveal truth through encounter with the Risen Christ, moving believers from darkness to light and fulfilling God's redemptive plan. It also offers us great hope for our loved ones and neighbors that have fallen away from the church or are living a life in which they don't "need" God.

Here are a few important themes for us to reflect on. First, is God's Divine intervention and the power of Grace. Saul (Paul) wasn't looking for Christ, he was actually trying to silence the name of Jesus. Yet, even so, God's love was poured into Saul as Jesus interrupted his "life's work" and thus, demonstrating that conversion is God's work, an act of grace.

Second is the radical transformation of Saul. He moved from a zealous persecutor of the Church to God's holy missionary disciple and apostle. We find in his conversion a complete reorientation of his identity, mission and understanding.

Finally, we find in St. Paul's conversion story hope, that no sin is too great to prevent grace. Anyone can experience Christ's transformative power, becoming a new creation. There are countless stories of individuals that have moved from a life of sin, to a life of grace in Christ and His Church. Probably many, if not most of us sitting here today, have had a conversion moment. Let us pray, that through the intercession of St. Paul, many more will move from a life of sin to a life of grace, accepting God's call to conversion.

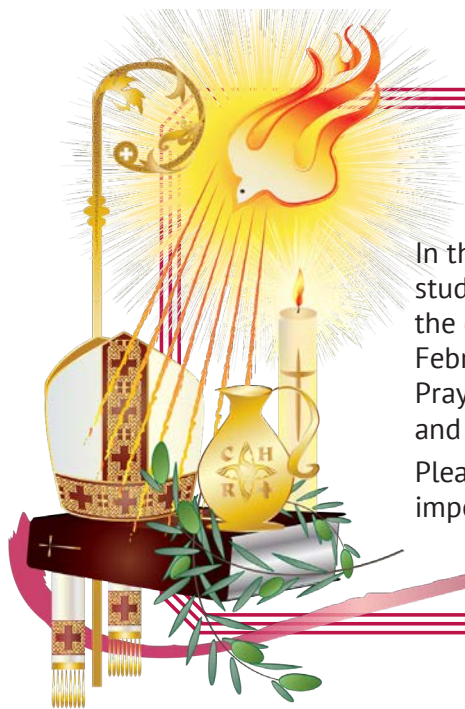
A Powerful Study on the Blessed Mother
