BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pcartwright@stpattroy.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

MENTAL WELLNESS FOR THE FAITHFUL

Peace be with you. In my most recent entry, I spoke about remedies for navigating distress and sorrow that were identified and encouraged by St. Thomas Aquinas. To refresh, those tips are pleasure, weeping, sympathy of friends, contemplating truth and taking a bath or sleeping. Now, I would like to begin offering a few practical tips regarding each of these remedies toward better integrating them into our lives. Today, let's begin by looking at pleasure. According to St. Thomas, "...every pleasure brings relief by assuaging any kind of sorrow." Thus, it is good for the body to experience momentary relief via pleasure when in a state of distress or sorrow. For example, think about bereavement ministry or meal trains. Yes, most times when overwhelmed with intense burden or sorrow, one of the last necessities we can look to address is eating, given that we are preoccupied with our burden. However, when we don't eat, this makes it even harder to navigate the burden given our limited energy and resources. And yet, meal trains and post-funeral meals are also really helpful in that they provide those heavily burdened with something pleasurable, such as food, sweets or drink, which can momentarily "assuage" our pain. This then makes the pain just a little more tolerable and allows us to relax for a minute. Now, two things. 1. It must be stated that disordered tolerance of pain through excess food or drink is not being encouraged here. But, if you're having a hard day and don't struggle with addiction, that glass of wine or slice of cake might indeed be just what you need. 2. Not all pleasure is just found in what we put in our mouths. Listening to delightful music or going for a walk in a place of beauty can also be helpful. Persevere my brothers and sisters, for God is with us always. Come and see.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN RAMBLINGS

Spirituality of fasting, penance & sacrifice...

One of my favorite Bryan Adams songs is his 1991 hit (*Everything I Do*) *I Do It For You*. As I was preparing this article on the spirituality of fasting, penance and sacrifices, the title of this song came to my mind, for I believe it captures how we should approach not just the Season of Lent, but our entire Christian experience. Our hearts should cry out and all our actions should reflect, "Everything I do, I do it for you," for Our Lord has done everything and more for us.

In the 2008 movie *Fireproof*, there is a powerful moment that can also show how we approach our relationship with God. The lead is played by Kirk Cameron. The story centers on a failing marriage from a lack of communication and commitment. A son talks to his dad for advice, and his father asked him to do the 40-day love challenge, which consisted of doing small acts of love for his wife to help rekindle their love. After a short period of time, she begins to question why he is doing things for her, as it seemed to be out of his normal character. He told her about the love challenge and she looked with tears in her eyes and said, "How can I believe you when you spend your time on that," and she points to the computer. He loses his temper and takes the computer outside and destroys it. When she gets home she sees a bouquet of roses instead, with a note that says, "I love you more than *this*." What a beautiful reminder that when we give something up we are saying, "Lord, I love you more than *this*." When we fast from meat on Friday, again we are saying, "Lord, I love you more than this meat." When we add extra prayers or works of mercy, we are saying, "Lord, everything I do, I do it for You!"

Our faith community has the pleasure to pray for and to walk alongside our Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) “elect” (those to be Baptized, along with the other Sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation at Easter Vigil) and “candidates” (those already Baptized, but coming into full communion with the Church with the other

Sacraments)! An Our Lady of Fatima planning team has been dedicated to listening, learning and revitalizing the OCIA experience – all to build an even more intimate, celebratory, intentional team setting to accompany and guide inquirers on their faith journey. This Cohort has entered into the “Period of Purification & Enlightenment.”

On the Third Sunday of Lent, our elect experienced the First Scrutiny at St. Mary, followed by a period of “Breaking Open the Word” with their full OCIA Cohort, focusing on the Gospel of the Samaritan Woman at the Well. The Scrutinies, like a child’s Baptism, offer a time for the elect to come forward to have prayers of exorcism and the laying on of hands, symbolizing their preparation for Baptism and their commitment to their new life in Christ. **But the Scrutinies are not just for the elect – they serve as a reminder to all Catholics to enter into self-reflection and to seek spiritual growth.**
