**Did You Know?**

The Paschal Triduum precedes the feast of Easter. The Triduum is a continuous liturgy that begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday (Holy Thursday) and concludes with the Easter Vigil, after sundown of Holy Saturday. It is most notable that there is no blessing at the end of Holy Thursday or Good Friday, signifying that the Liturgy has not concluded yet.

**The Divine Mercy Novena** (nine-day prayer) may be prayed at home or in communion with other faithful, beginning on Good Friday.
