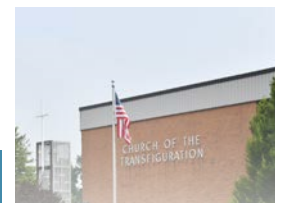

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CONTACT YOUR CHURCH OFFICE!

PARISHIONER CONTACT INFO: Be sure to keep your address, phone number and e-mail up-to-date with your registered church, so you don't miss important things.

BAPTISM – *Congrats, New Parents!* Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

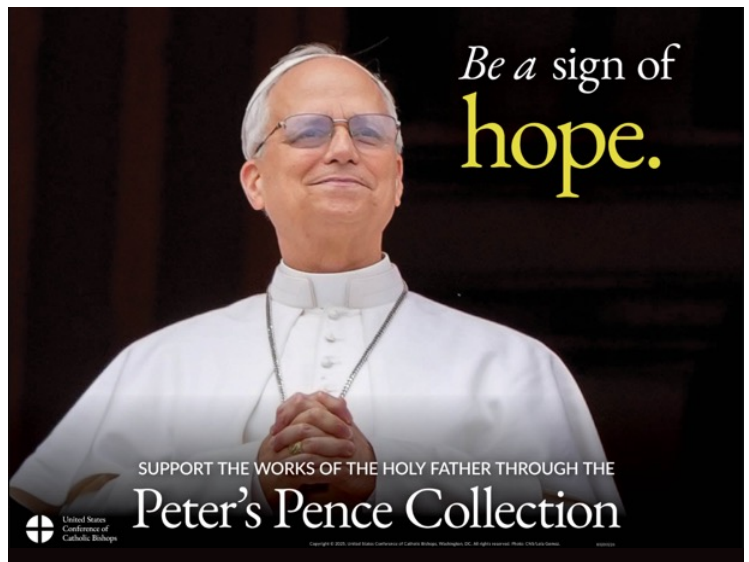

ARCHDIOCESE SAFE ENVIRONMENT OFFICE UPDATE

Effective July 1, the selection.com fee for the initial online/electronic background check required for all NEW employees and volunteers will increase from \$25 to \$30.

The Safe Environment Office of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati continuously reviews its procedures to ensure the highest standards of child protection. In alignment with U.S.C.C.B. recommendations, we are expanding our background check protocols. In addition to the ongoing quarterly updates from the selection.com database, all electronic background checks will now require renewal every five years.

- Individuals who are SafeParish trained and have a background check older than five years will need to renew their background check.
- Those individuals will receive an email from SafeParish with detailed instructions on how to complete the renewal.
- Check Spam or Junk folders regularly.
- A \$20 fee will be charged by selection.com. In some cases, additional county clerk fees may apply.

MASS INTENTIONS ARE NOW OPEN FOR THE NEW JULY 1 FISCAL YEAR!

We offer Masses for our deceased loved ones to aid them in their journeys to heaven. We pray with hope that the graces imparted by the Mass usher them further towards eternity with God. You may also have a Mass said for someone who is living which comes with additional graces. Stop into your church office to schedule a Mass for someone who has passed or to honor someone who is living. Intention Guidelines:

1. A maximum of ten (10) announced Mass Intentions per year from any one individual may be scheduled.
2. No more than (1) Intention per non-Purgatorian Mass. Purgatorian Masses (designated as Purgatorian” Masses) may have up to (5) five Intentions noted in total reserved by the faithful.
3. Intention requests will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis with a \$5 gift per Intention (as defined by the AOC) payable at the church office.

Our Lady of Fatima's church offices will be closed on Friday, July 3 in observance of Independence Day. There will be NO NEW OLF BULLETIN EDITIONS on July 5-6 weekend. You will only need to take one on June 27-28, the following weekend's remaining copies will be the same edition.

WELCOME, SEMINARIANS! Ryan Carraro & Dcn. Bao Duong

You will see these gentlemen at Masses and visiting and helping at special events throughout Our Lady of Fatima Family of Parishes through early August!

Ryan will be working for St. Boniface and St. Mary as part of the summer seminarian work program as he shares his time, talents and maintenance skills on our properties. Ryan shared his vocational story with us:

"It all started when I received the Sacrament of Confirmation. After that Mass, I experienced a deep desire to become a priest. Although I spent many years running from that call, it never completely disappeared. Then, after returning to Confession for the first time in almost 10 years, I experienced God's mercy in a profound way, and the desire for the priesthood came back stronger than ever. It has remained with me ever since I grew up in Milford and joined the Marine Corps Reserves and attended NKU with hopes of becoming an officer after graduation. Through my involvement at the Newman Center, where I later served as president, I fell in love with Jesus and His Church. Many of my friends could see that God was calling me to the seminary long before I was willing to admit it. By God's grace, I entered seminary in August 2023 and have just completed my third year of formation. Saint Ignatius of Loyola is my favorite saint because we have some similar experiences. The injuries I received in the military led me to have a deeper conversion and ultimately opened my heart to a vocation of service in the Church. Like Ignatius, I learned that God's plans are often different and greater than our own."

Our former seminarian intern, "Bao," was ordained a transitional deacon this spring as part of his vocational call toward the priesthood – He is now Dcn. Duong! He felt so "at home" within Our Lady of Fatima this past year that he requested to stay with us for a couple months as he sharpens his new preaching skills and ministry work! Fr. Eric invited him to preach during upcoming Masses:

ST. PATRICK CATHOLIC CHURCH CAPITAL PROJECT

BIG NEWS! Phase III – in addition to the original improvement plan for the parish office front walk, soffit, porch and steps – will include major improvements to the handicap ramp and a new configuration for the church sign!



PHASE III - PARISH OFFICE FRONT | SUMMER 2026

ADA compliance on the ramp and door including the ramp grading, railings, repositioning of the automatic button, a rest-landing, new ADA railings, a snow-melt system and proper clearance for wheelchairs upon the door opening have all been considerations in this major project.

To keep the church open and Masses continuing at St. Patrick during this time, the Main Street and Crawford Street doors will remain open. **The handicap ramp door will not be open.** Please help notify those who utilize walkers or wheelchairs that they will need alternate Mass attendance plans during this temporary period while the church becomes even more accessible for the future. *(If a parishioner needs to discuss individual dispensation considerations, s/he may contact Fr. Eric directly.)* Please anticipate that the side hallway and bathroom will be inaccessible for safety and to not interrupt work in the ramp door area. The downstairs/ undercroft bathrooms will be utilized. Now that we have received the proper renderings, have received appropriate clearance and vendors have been secured, work will begin as early as the week of June 22.

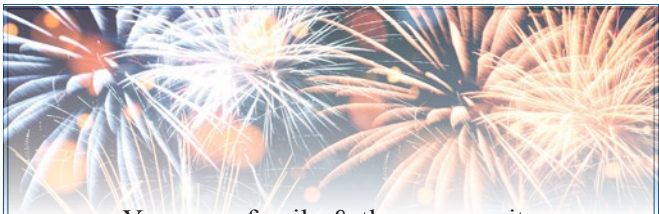

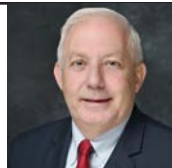
