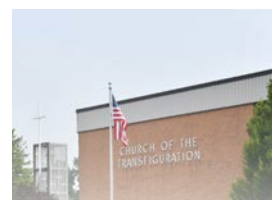

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

MEETING A SERVANT OF GOD

Back in 2024, I had my first encounter with a Servant of God. As a seminarian, I had often been bothered that I knew so little about those who had been given this title. If I knew so little about Servants of God, I wondered how many parishioners had ever heard of them. It saddened me because these holy men and women can easily be forgotten since they have not yet been officially recognized as saints, even though they may one day be canonized.

A Servant of God is someone whose cause for canonization has officially begun. The faithful are encouraged to learn about their lives, seek their intercession, and pray for miracles through them as the Church discerns their path toward beatification and canonization.

The Servant of God who profoundly touched my life is Chiara Corbella Petrillo. While studying in Rome, I made a pilgrimage with fellow seminarians to her tomb on the anniversary of her death. During the pilgrimage, another seminarian shared her remarkable story, and I quickly understood why so many had been inspired by her witness.

Chiara was born in Rome in 1984 and later married her husband, Enrico. During her first two pregnancies, their children were diagnosed before birth with severe, life-limiting conditions. Rather than ending either pregnancy, Chiara lovingly carried both children to term, baptizing and cherishing them during the brief time they lived after birth.

Despite this heartbreaking loss, Chiara became pregnant a third time. Although her baby was healthy, she was diagnosed with an aggressive cancer. She delayed more aggressive treatment to protect the life of her unborn son. Francesco was born healthy in May 2011. After his birth, Chiara resumed treatment, but the cancer had already spread. Surrounded by her family, she faced her final months with remarkable peace, joy, and trust in God. She died on June 13, 2012, at just 28 years of age.

Chiara's witness is one of radiant hope. She showed that authentic love means giving oneself completely, even when it comes at great personal cost. If you would like to learn more about her inspiring life, I highly recommend *Chiara Corbella Petrillo: A Witness to Joy* by Simone Troisi and Cristiana Paccini, published by Sophia Institute Press.

Servant of God Chiara Corbella Petrillo, pray for us. Pray especially for mothers facing difficult pregnancies, for families carrying the cross of loss, and for all who are called to choose life in hidden and heroic ways. Help us to trust that every human life is a precious gift from God.

FACILITIES UPDATES



Hear that? No? Well, that's because background noise has been now been removed at St. Patrick!

A couple necessary improvements are being made inside St. Patrick to enhance the liturgical experience.



During a sound assessment, it was determined that the constant loud fan that was running inside each of the beautiful light fixtures – meant to keep the lights from getting too hot – should be replaced. It caused a lot of background noise in the church. Those bulbs and fans have now been removed and updated! The work was completed by Rayner Electric.

Sound adjustments are being made in stages. The wireless and ambo microphones have been calibrated, settings updated and damaged wires have been replaced to reduce feedback and to magnify our priests', deacons' and lectors' voices. There's already a marked improvement!

Another stage of sound repair is coming soon.

Lastly, you've also likely caught sight of the custom wooden railings that were handcrafted by Russell and depart the tabernacle.
