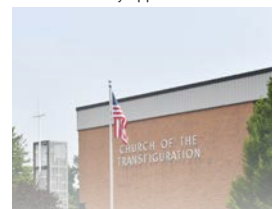

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

VICAR'S VOICE

ESCHATOLOGY: THE FOUR LAST THINGS | CONTRIBUTED BY: *Fr. Jacob Schmiesing*

The start of a new school year is one of the first heralds that summer is wrapping up and fall is coming. Football season, orange leaves, and pumpkins are around the corner, and (hopefully) the heat and humidity are fading into the rearview mirror. In her liturgical life, the Church reflects many of the natural movements of the seasons, and always has. Thus, as the (environmental) seasons change, the (liturgical) seasons and emphases change, too.

As fall progresses, the Church shifts her focus to the “ends” of various things. Paralleling the dying greenery and shortening days outside, the readings at Mass often deal with what are called the “Four Last Things:” death, judgment, heaven and hell. While some of these terms may evoke an initial negative reaction, the Church is striving to help us recognize that, at the end of our lives, the “Four Last Things” await us. We will all die and stand before God in judgment, before spending eternity in either heaven or hell. However, this should not unsettle us or stir up fear, but rather, it should inspire us to hope in God’s grace and mercy and to pray for those who have died before us. In order to approach death and what follows in a healthy, prepared spiritual state, the Church takes time each fall to focus on these realities and how we should think about them.

In broader theology, the study of the end of our lives and the end of time is called “eschatology.” This term is derived from the Greek word *eskhatos*, meaning “last” or “extreme.” The field of eschatology is so essential to our faith because we believe that death is not the end; something awaits us on the other side. We live filled with hope of eternal life, but that does not mean that our lives are easy or that we won’t fear death when it comes. Death has a real finality about it, and so, preparing for it well can help bring great peace when that day comes.

As an introduction to eschatology, our family of parishes will be hosting a course on the “Four Last Things” beginning in September. This is a great way to start learning and thinking about these truths that can be intimidating, but that we must be willing to face head-on, because eventually we will. I encourage you to consider joining this course, as I can personally guarantee that it applies to your life, along with everyone else’s. **Keep reading for how to register.**

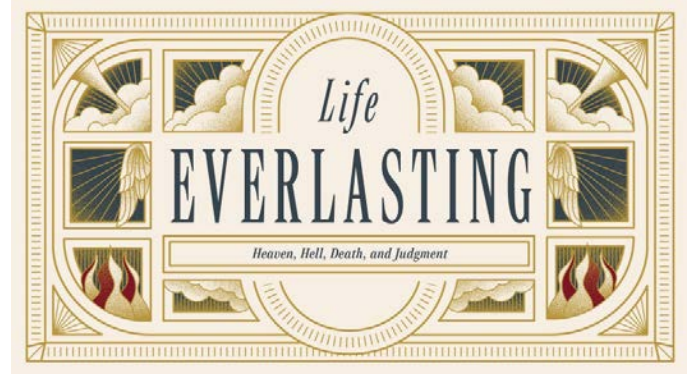

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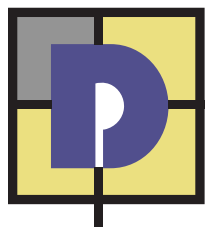
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
