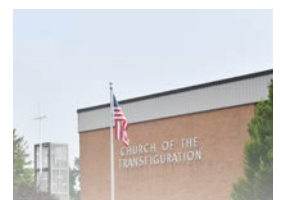

BAPTISM – Congrats, New Parents! Class is required, by appointment. Prior to Baptizing your child, register for your Baptism Class: pat@fatima-family.org | 937-335-2833. OLF Baptism Classes are held at St. Patrick Parish Center (white building behind the school), upstairs Room 3.

MATRIMONY: Schedule at least nine months in advance. Preparation program and parish registration is required.

ANointing OF THE SICK: Those weakened by age, afflicted by serious illness or preparing for serious surgery should receive this sacrament.

HOMEBOUND: Extraordinary Ministers can be arranged to visit homes and nursing facilities with the Eucharist for those unable to worship on Sundays.

SAFEPARISH: In order to serve as a volunteer with children within Our Lady of Fatima, you must be Archdiocesan-compliant and registered with the SafeParish program.

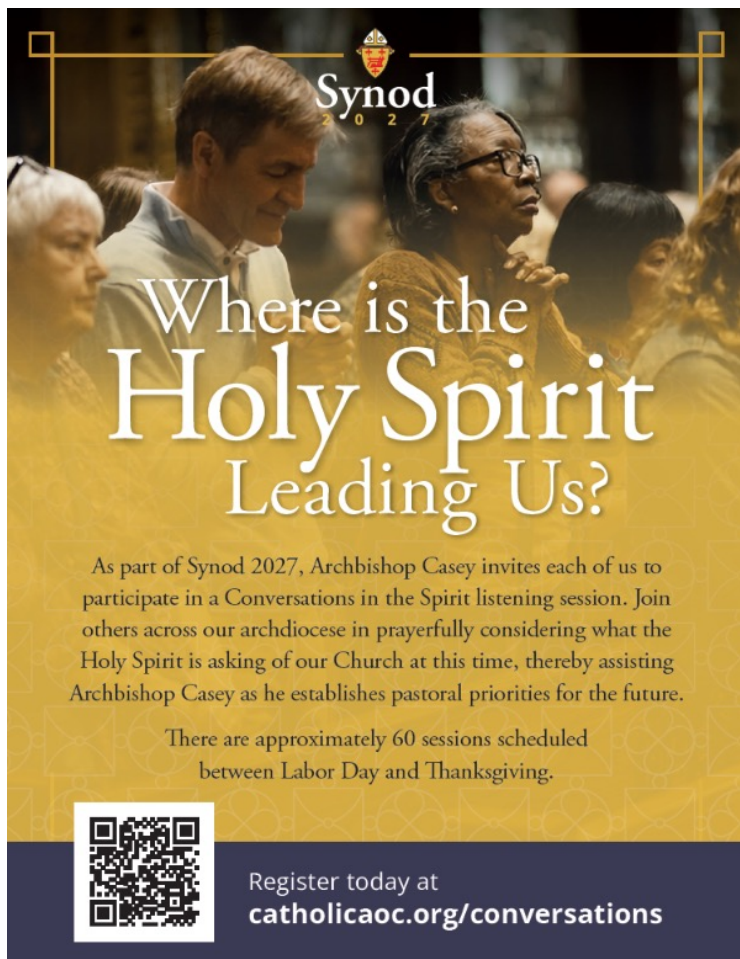

Peace be with you. We recently completed our series where we unpacked St. Thomas Aquinas' remedies for navigating distress and sorrow. *I'd like to revisit the sympathy of friends.* If you were to describe what I do, you wouldn't be too far off if you described me as a professional, really caring and capable friend. Most people often come to me with this belief that I have a rolodex of remedies, tools and guidance regarding more effective ways they can navigate their problems. This is partially true. However, what ends up being true most of the time is that my patients are as smart if not smarter than I am. Yet, when we are in deep pain, it can really limit our creative thinking and undermine our growth and flourishing. In turn, I'd like to offer one piece of advice. The next time someone comes to you with a deep personal suffering, try to hold off from fixing their problem for them. Rather, make sure that both you and they know that you are truly here for them, trying your best to fully understand what is going on for them and how it hurts. When this occurs, the one suffering then begins to feel less burdened, less alone, more seen and more human. And, isn't that what we all want most in these tough times? Come and see.

FR. ERIC BOWMAN'S RAMBLINGS

No Man Left Behind

At the end of June, I spent an evening with one of our families whose son was leaving the next morning for West Point to begin his army career. It was extremely enjoyable, as I shared a bunch of basic training horror stories the same way my dad did to me before I left for basic training in July 1988. I have been thinking a lot about my time in the military following that dinner.

One of the most important concepts of basic training that becomes the bedrock foundation of a military career is fraternal bonding. Through the shared experiences, a "brotherhood" is formed that is so strong it leads to the popular phrase: "No man left behind." Most of us have seen a military movie or television show that has this phrase as a theme. But what does it look like practically, and how can one apply it to their spiritual life? In basic and advanced training, this principle can be lived out in how one cares for his fellow soldier. For example, we all had to do 42 push-ups within two minutes, and I was struggling with my goals. I kept getting close but was always three to six short. My buddies began to push me, work with me, encourage me until finally I reached my goal. Or, if someone was having a hard time with the running goals, we would drop back in formation to run with them, to encourage them, to pick them up and to push them forward. This was done in any portion of our military training, to push, pick up and encourage our brothers.

Over the past several years, I have been reflecting on how my experience as a soldier, and the discipline/commitment that can apply to our spiritual life as well. First and foremost, we all need to understand that we are in the battle of our lives everyday. St. Peter in his first letter writes, "Be sober, be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." (1 Peter 5:8) St. Paul tells us, "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we are not contending against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." (Eph 6:1-12) He then lists all the armor of God we are called to wear for the battle against evil. We must approach this battle with the same mindset of "No man left behind." We need to encourage, build up, lift up, and even carry them through the battle. No matter how broken, wounded or close to "death," we must pick them up and carry them to safety. Like the medic of "Hacksaw Ridge" who spent an entire day/night behind enemy lines looking for the wounded to carry to safety, we, too, must approach our neighbors, our brothers/sisters in the Lord with the same urgency. NO SOUL LEFT BEHIND!
